SPRING ARRIVED EARLY this year following a mild winter with little snowfall. For the past few weeks, we experienced several days where the all time record was broken for daily high temperature. Several days last week were in the low eighties, making if feel like late May. To date, not including labor and equipment, we used \$185,529 for snow and ice control materials (salt, cinders, grits) This compares with \$315,755 last year, and \$362,726 the year before.

With the warm weather, the 2012 construction season has officially begun. On March 12, Ohio/West Virginia Excavating Co. started a \$647,135 County Highway 10 Bridge Replacement Project. The new bridge will be a two span concrete box beam deck 98 feet in length, 28 feet wide. This bridge is expected to be finished in early summer.

In the past three weeks, two bridges built by our bridge crew, were completed and opened to traffic. The first one is located on Somerset Township 4 located on the Noble County line near Temperanceville, and is a steel beam bridge with a steel open grated deck. The other is a concrete box beam structure located on **Richland Township 279** over Little McMahon Creek.

On April 4, bids will be opened for the 210' long, 20' high retaining wall along County Highway 5, Ramsey



Ridge Road. This is a FEMA funded project needed as a result of last year's heavy rainfall in April and May.

Later this year, we will be bidding several other projects, including new bridges and retaining walls. Dates of the bid openings will be determined in the near future.

With the little snowfall we received, and the warmer than usual temperatures so far in 2012, let me remind you that Easter is a couple weeks away, and we usually get an "Easter Snow".

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The bridge replacement project on Richland Township Road 279, McMahon Creek, was completed on March 22nd and opened to traffic.





The Somerset Township Road 4, Pfeffer Road, bridge replacement project was completed on March 12th.
