SUMMER IS HERE, and the construction season is in full swing. Within the past few weeks contractors for Ascent Resources – Utica, LLC have been upgrading and paving a few of our roads. County Highway 56 (Morgan Hill Road), from Colerain Township Road 451 (Grays Ridge Road) to US 250 in Jefferson County was finished last week, and CH 18 (Lansing Cheermont Road) from US 250 to CH 20 (Blaine Cheermont Road), and CH 20 to the oil pad are now being upgraded and paved.

Aero Mark, Inc. should begin striping about 137 miles of centerline any day now. This \$147,776 project should be completed before July.

Bids were opened this week for furnishing and applying 52,500 gallons of Bituminous Liquid Asphalt Materials for dust control. Two bids were received and now are being reviewed. The low bid was from Youngblood Paving Inc. of Wampum, PA in the amount of \$141,300. The only other bid was from Lash Paving Co. of Colerain, OH in the amount of \$142,575. This project is expected to be awarded in a couple of weeks.

BUDS, Inc. is now working on our first of 10 bridges being built by ODOT as part of their Ohio's Bridge Partnership Program (OBPP). This bridge is on Colerain Township 426 (Buzz Ayers Road) and will be a three sided concrete box culvert. BUD'S, Inc. will be building three other bridges this year, one on Pultney T-304 (Trough Run Road), one on CH 4 Willow Grove Road) and one on Richland T-289 (Cumberland Run Road). All four bridges will be completed this year.

ODOT will soon be bidding the remaining six bridges. These are design-build projects, and will be designed this year and built next year. ODOT will also soon be bidding two emergency slip repair project, one on St. Clairsville-Barton Road, and one on Kirkwood Heights.

Other projects will be bid within the next few months and will be reported on later.
