



just: that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to the public to justify the payment of said compensation out of the bounty treasury; and no petition for review being filed, it is ordered that the county auditor draw his order upon the county treasurer in favor of said claimants for the amount of compensation so awarded them, respectfully: that the several reports of the viewers with the survey and plat of said road be recorded and that said road be established a public highway.
