

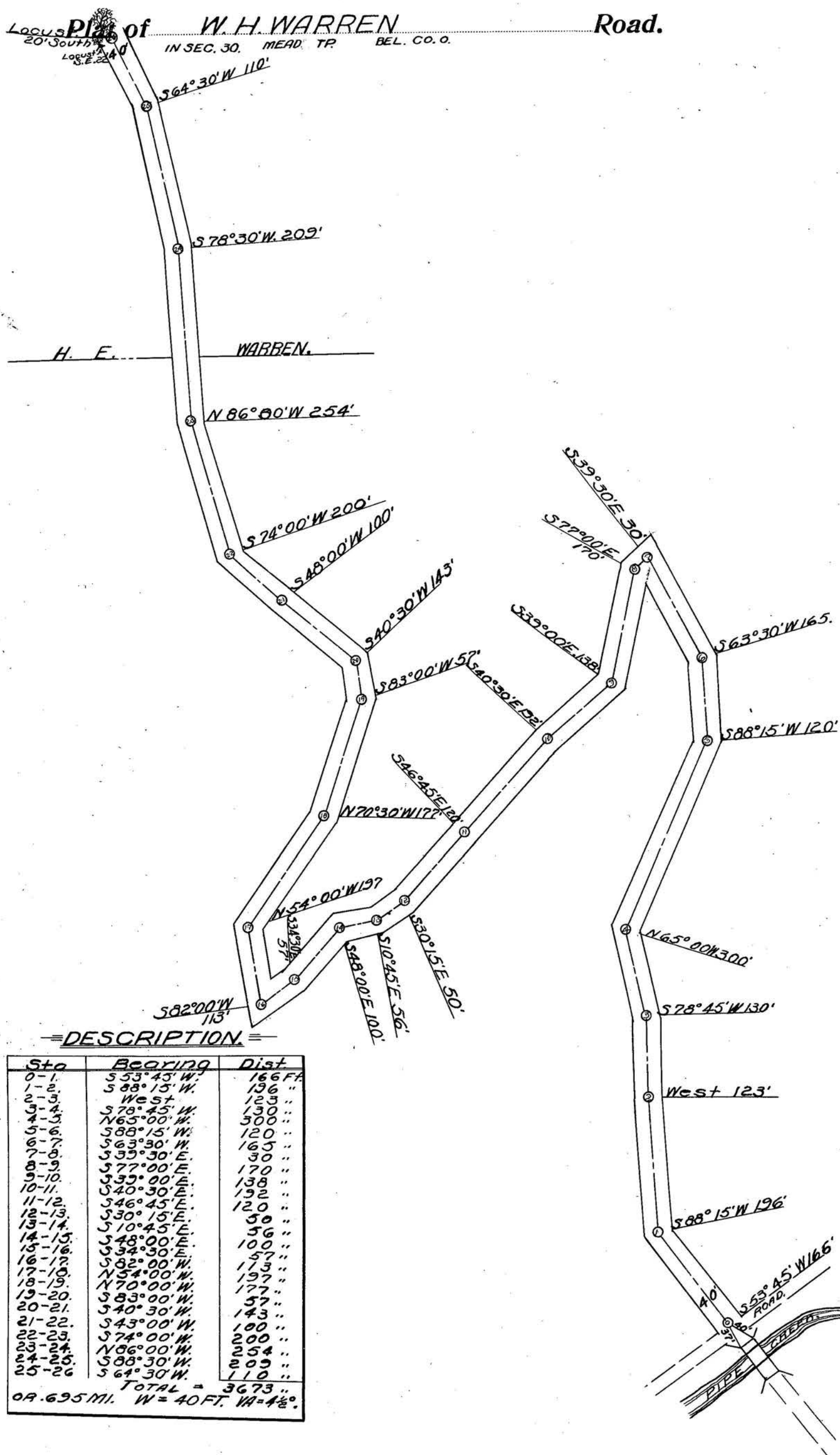
Surveyor's Report.

ROAD PETITION.

For W. W. SUTTON ET ALRoad in RICHLAND TOWNSHIP

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

WE THE UNDERSIGNED PETITIONERS-RESIDENT FREEHOLDERS OF SAID COUNTY-RESIDING IN THE VICINITY OF THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED RESPECTFULLY REPRESENT THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE REQUIRES THE ALTERATION OF A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD KNOWN AS THE ST. CLAIRS VILLE AND DILLIES BOTTOM ROAD ON THE ~~E~~ LINE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED AND PRAY THAT YOUR HONORABLE BODY WILL INSTITUTE AND ORDER THE PROPER PROCEEDINGS IN THE PREMISES TO ESTABLISH SUCH ROAD TO/WIT.

BEGINNING FOR SAID ALTERATION AT AN IRON PIN AT THE INTERSECTION OF SAID ST. CLAIRS-VILLE AND DILLIES BOTTOM ROAD AND THE GLENCOE ROAD ON THE LAND OF W. W. SUTTON IN THE NORTH EAST QUARTER OF SECTION 1 TOWNSHIP 7 IN RANGE 4 BELMONT COUNTY OHIO. THENCE THRU THE LAND OF W. W. SUTTON IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION TO OR NEAR A WALNUT STUMP. THENCE IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION A POINT IN SAID ST. CLAIRSVILLE AND DILLIES BOTTOM ROAD NEAR AN ASH TREE MAKING A UNIFORM GRADE FROM THE PLACE OF BEGINNING TO HIS POINT. THENCE WITH THE PRESENT ROAD TO A POINT OPPOSITE W. W. SUTTONS MAIL BOX. THENCE IN A NORTHWESTERLY DIRECTION TO A WALNUT TREE 15 INCHES IN DIAMETER ON THE LAND OF LAVINA AULT. THENCE CONTINUING IN A NORTHEASTERLY DIRECTION BY A UNIFORM GRADE THRU THE LAND OF LAVINA AULT TO AN IRON PIN IN THE PRESENT ROAD OPPOSITE A GATE POST. DATED THIS 6TH DAY OF AUGUST A. D. 1913.

penses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in

full force in law.

In obedience to your order, issued at your Special session, A. D. 1913, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with D. C. Kennon Surveyor, at W. W. Sutton 29th of October and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

John Dunn and M. J. Gault were selected by us as chain carriers, and R. D. Sutton as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the of said road as follows:

We would respectfully report that the said Road ought to be opened for the following reasons:

- 1st For the benefit of the public
- 2^d Being a good grade and Road easily made, we recommend the vacation of the old road.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Road shall be established 40 feet in width.
