The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration of a County road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to Alter such road, to-wit: Beginning at from near Stillwater meeting house to Captina Creek, near the residence of Uriah Hartley, said Alteration to commence north of the creek on the line of the lands of Aaron Tramo and Benjamin Stanton, thence to run in a North westerly direction ^{said Stanton's line until it intersects} or near the road leading from Somerset to Morristown. And also that so much of the present road as is rendered unnecessary be vacated.

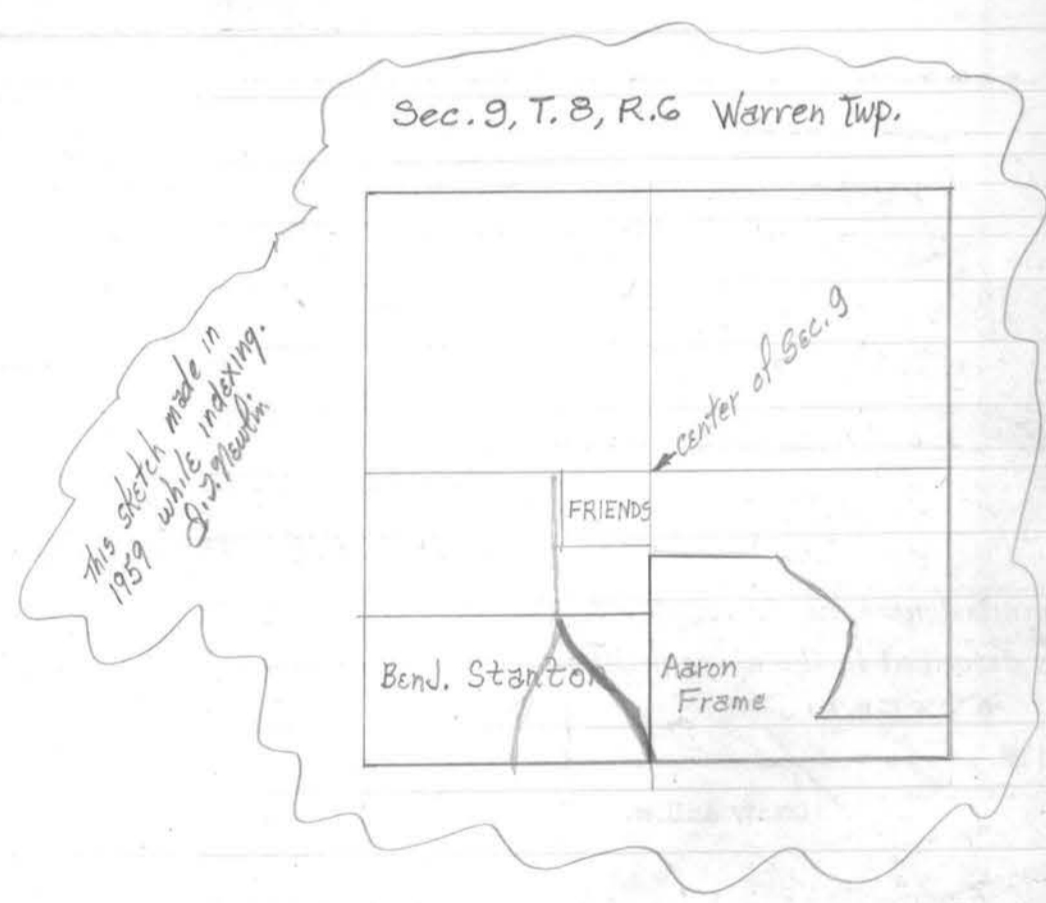
REPORT OF VIEWERS.
