The Commissioners met in regular session, and the report of the viewers in relation to the establishment of said Altarum, was this day publicly read. Being the third reading of the same, and said viewers having filed a separate report, in writing, of the amount of compensation which they have assessed to Thos. Aulh, a landowner, by reason of the location of said road through his premises. Said report was also publicly read. And the Board being of opinion that the compensation awarded by said viewers, to-wit, to Thomas Aulh Thirty five dollars 35⁰⁰, by

Compensatim is reasonable and just, that said road will be of public utility and of sufficient importance to justify the payment of said compensation out of the County Treasury, and no petition for review being filed, it is ordered that the County Auditor draw his order upon the County Treasurer, in favor of said claimant, for the amount of compensation so awarded to him, that the several repairs of the viaduct, with the survey and plat of said road, be recorded, and that said road be established a public highway. It is further ordered, that the County Auditor issue in the name of the Board, an order to the Trustees of Smith Township, directing them to cause said road to be opened according to law.


