Thence along the line between the lands of John Galloway, and the heirs of S. Campbell to a stake marked "B" Thence through the lands of John Galloway to a stake marked "C" Thence through the land of the heirs of William Campbell, to a stake marked "D" Thence through the lands of Thomas Dew, to stake marked "E" on the Fairview & Barnesville road and thence to terminate.

Thence along the line between the lands of John Galloway, and the heirs of S Campbell, to stake marked "B" Thence through the lands of John Galloway, to a stake marked "C" Thence through the lands of the heirs of Wm. Campbell, to a stake marked "D" Thence through the lands of Thomas Dew, to a stake marked "E" on the Fairview & Barnesville road and thence to terminate

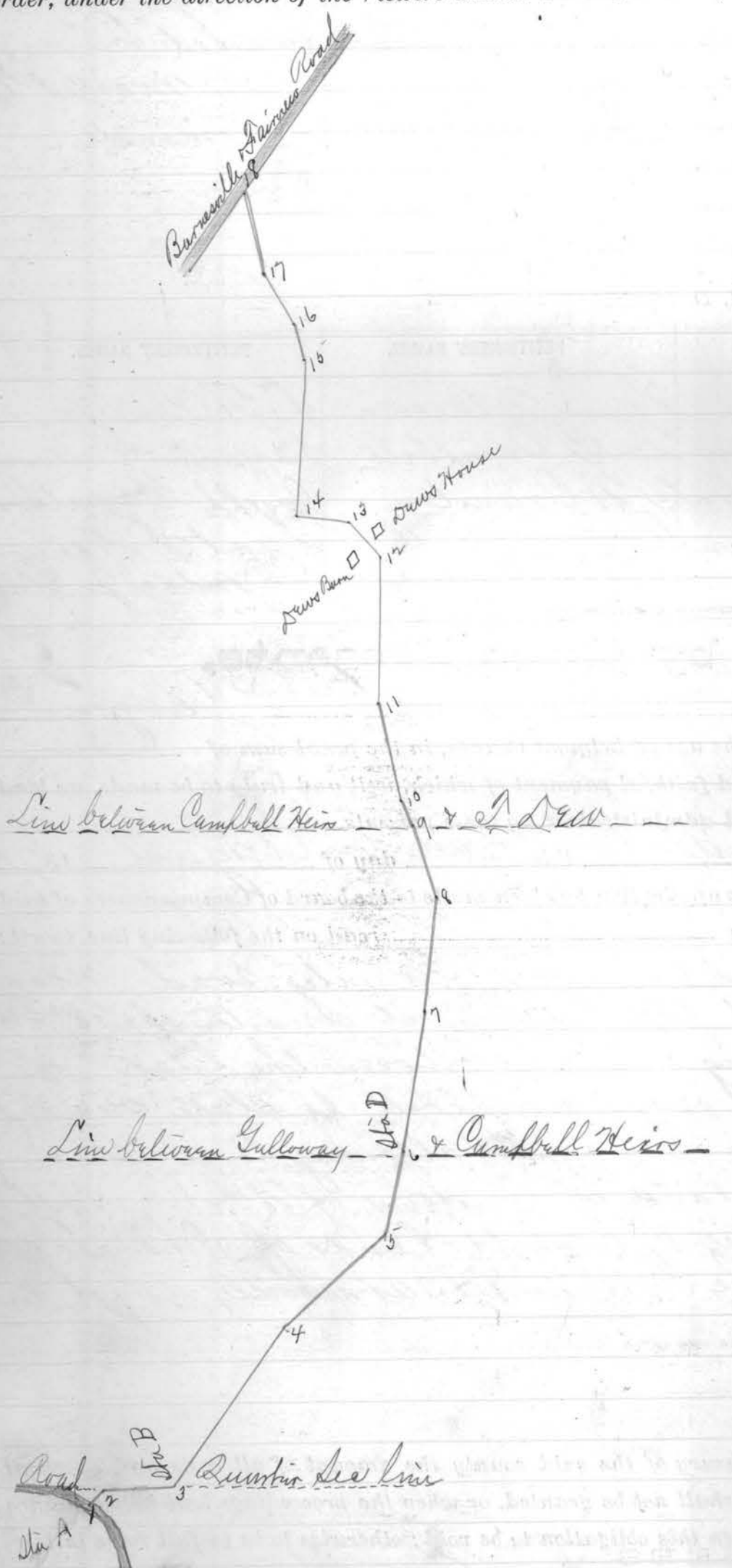

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your September session, A. D. 1878, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Chalkley Dawson Surveyor, at J. B. Galloway on Said Road and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

If any viewer is unable to attend, here state by whom the vacancy was filled.

John Forbes and D. C. Kemmon were selected by us as chain carriers, and Allen Floyd as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:

We would respectfully report that the said Road ought not to be granted for the following reasons:

Damages to Thomas Dew for land taken \$75.00 dollars for cost of building lane fences \$250.00 and other damages \$183.00 making in all \$508.00 we also think that it is of sufficient public utility to say that amount of damages also that we are of the opinion that it will be to the advantage of J. B. Galloway and the Cummins farm and probably some others also the line of road as located is not the cheapest and best that could now be made. We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such County road if granted shall be established thirty feet in width.

such road, to-wit: Beginning at for the same a short distance

north of St Georges Mill Dam and on the road leading from the National Road to the Uniontown and Flushing Pike, thence in a westerly course on the north side of a small run past said Georges Coal Bank, thence across the corner of James P Newlin's land and along the line between said Newlin and John C Patterson to the lands of Martha Robb, or as near as practicable, thence on the south of said Martha Robb's stable and orchard to the corner of timber in her field, thence in a west course through the lands of Robt Boyd dead, to the road leading from the National Road to Uniontown.

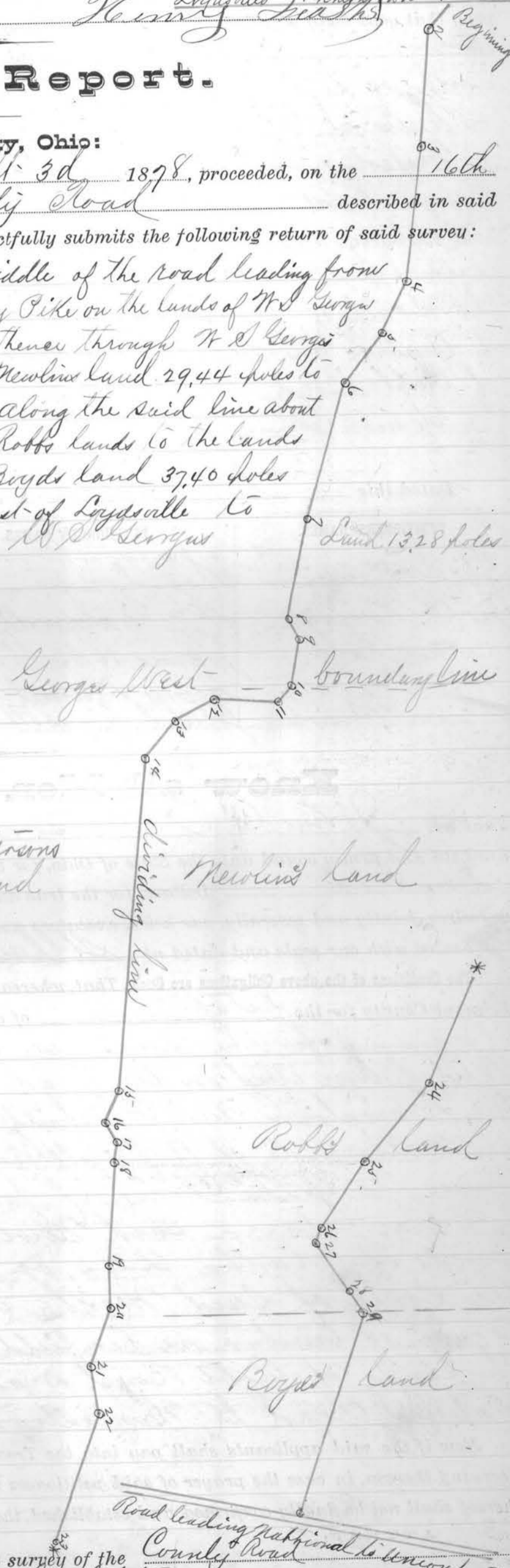

Patterson's South boundary line; Thence along the said line about 100 rods; thence through the lands of Martha Robbs lands to the lands of Robert Boyd Heirs; thence through said Boyds land 37.40 poles to intersect the road leading from the National West of Loydsville to Uniontown

Laban Lodge and Bruce Runaga were selected by us as chain carriers, and Lev Robb as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the _____ of said road as follows:

Beginning for the same 24 links Southeast of the east end of a Culvert at a stake in the middle of the road leading from Loydsville or leading from the National Road a little east of Loydsville on the lands of H S George. thence in a Northwestly direction through the said George's land & through the land of James P Newlin.
