The Conditions of the above Obligations are Such, That, whereas application has been made to the board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the Alteration of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Said road being the road leading from the state road on Pipe Creek on the lands of William Trigg to Glencow. Said Alteration to commence on the lands of Said Trigg at or near the begining of the Old road, thence in a Northerly direction through the lands of Said Trigg, H B Simpson & Samuel Myers & Brothers, J M Phillips, W H Watt, Henry Neff, and Isaac Muck to intersect the old road near Mucks Mill.

Now if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.



Surveyor's Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated Sept 3d 1878, proceeded, on the 16th day of October 1878 to survey and mark the Route of an Alteration of a County road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at a Stake on the land of Mr. Trigg on the State Road on Pipe Creek. Then in a Northerly direction nearly following the old road leading from said Stake to Glenon. The following is a Survey and Plat of said road.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:


In obedience to your order, issued at your September session, A. D. 1878, we, the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with James Crossgrove Surveyor, at Wm. Trigg on 16th of Oct. 1878 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

If any viewer is unable to attend, here state by whom the vacancy was filled.

J. J. Delong and Thos. O. Trigg, were selected by us as chain carriers, and J. W. Simpson as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Alteration of a County road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:

Beginning for the same on the Creek on the lands of Wm. Trigg and on the State road, thence through the lands of Wm. Trigg, in a northerly course thence by same course through the lands of W. B. Simpson, Samuel Myers & Bro. J. W. Phillips, W. H. Watt, Henry Neff, and Isaac McEachan intersects the old road near Muske Mill on Little McMahons Creek for further description see Surveyors report.



We would respectfully report that the said Alteration ought to be Established for the following reasons:

The old road is much worn in places and in others very steep. The proposed Alteration is very much better grade for a road and on good ground. Can be made at reasonable expense, and in our opinion the public convenience requires that said Alteration be made.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Alteration shall be established Thirty feet in width.

Samuel Myers et al by their attorney Dewitt Danford gives notice of Appeal from Assessment of Compensation and Damages

Order issued Jan'y 9th 79

Hartsville, O. Dec. 8th 1874,

In the matter of the petition of John Henderson et al. for the said petition was this day publicly read the second time, and thereupon came vacatin of County Road William H. Majors and seven other fruhholders of the County of Belmont, and filed their written objections to the vacatin of said road, it is, therefore ordered, that one or more of said objections enter into a bond, payable to the State of Ohio, for the use of the County, in the sum of One Hundred dollars, conditioned for the payment of the rents of a view of said road, in case the same finally vacated, with securities to be approved by this Board, before further proceedings be had upon said objections.

In the matter of the petition of John Henderson et al. for the said petition was this day publicly read the second time, and thereupon came vacatin of County Road, bond in accordance with the former order of the Board, with Jonathan Perkins surety thereon, which is accepted and approved, And it is ordered that William Calm, Jesse Thomas and Peter Bramhall, three disinterested persons, be and they hereby are, appointed a Committee to view said road, and report their opinion as to the vacatin of the same, according to law; And that they at Henry Frasher on the 12th day of January 1875 at 10 o'clock A.M. and after having performed the duties of their appointment, that they make report to this Board at its next regular session.
