
Surveyor's Report.

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated June 7th 1880, proceeded, on the 10th day of August to survey and mark the Route of a County road as described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Beginning at a white oak tree marked in the County road leading from David Ramsey's to Dorsey's mill in said County near a gale on the hill on lands of Wm. Taylor in tract N. in sec. 31, Range 3, thence running with the gales in the following table to a stake in the middle of a County road leading from Pipe Creek to Dorsey's mill there to terminate. A locust 15 in. diam. bears N 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ E distance from said stake

In obedience to your order, issued at your June session, A. D. 1880, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with James Crosgrow Surveyor, at the place designated in your order and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, do hereby certify that the above-named persons are the true and correct signers of the foregoing report.

Isaac Coffman and Martin Caldwell were selected by us as chain carriers, and L. H. Green as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Cornely Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:

described in the report of the surveyor enclosed herewith, being on page 5 of this pamphlet and which report we make a part of our own

We would respectfully report that the said Road ought not to be established for the following reasons: We are of the opinion that a good road can be made along the route, surveyed, with but an ordinary amount of labor, and we believe that the public convenience requires said road, and that it will accommodate some who have no convenient way from and to their dwellings & premises.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Cornely road shall be established thirty feet in width.


