ROAD PETITION.

*of Belmont County
For the location and alteration of Roads in Wheeling Township*

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said county, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the location and alteration of ~~the roads in~~ Roads in ~~the~~ Wheeling Township, Belmont County, Ohio, on the lines hereinafter described; and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to locate and alter such roads, to-wit: Beginning at the County Road leading from Blushung to Harrisville near Abram Brooks in Wheeling Township, Belmont County, Ohio, running thence on the west side of the hollow on the lands of Wm H. Watson to a gun log and two white oak trees in a line thence to a white oak on the County road, on the Creek, across the Creek below the water gate on the lands of said Watson, thence to the County road following the same to off gate road running to said Watson's residence and also if necessary road shall be granted over as far as the present road leading from said Brooks to the confluence of the new road near the Creek shall be vacated. Road No 2 we also ask your Honorable Board to grant a new road commencing at the said County road at off Watson's gate road following the same to the Harrison County line, to connect with a road to be laid out in Harrison County through the lands of George D. See, Lure & Robert Henderson and Hayes McCrackley, to connect with the County road leading from Uniontown to New Athens near Park Night School, about Road No 3. We also ask the grant of a new road connecting at the point where the County road from the Creek to St. Paul's Town crosses the Harrison County line, and following said line east fifty or sixty rods to another County Road and back to that part of said St. Paul's Town road from the Harrison County line to the Creek Road.



REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your July session, A. D. 1880, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Marshall Thompson Surveyor, at Wm H Watsons on July 18th 1880 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order.

Albert Lee and Wm H Watsons were selected by us as chain carriers, and Samuel Brookaw as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Roads on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Location of said road as follows:

Commencing at the County Road leading from Clusking to Harrisville near AbroSam Brookaws in Wheling Townships to Watsons Gate as near the points described in your order for changing said road as a good road could conveniently be made. Second View. Commencing near Watsons gate and following the line of the present private way through the lands of said Watsons to the Harrison County line running with the road laid out in Harrison County as afford to in your order. Third View Commencing at the point where the County Road from the Creek to Plumtown crosses the Harrison County line and running each parallel with said County line to another County Road specified in your order for more particular description of these several views see Surveyors Report hereto attached.

We would respectfully report that the said roads ought to be established for the following reasons. First the Public will be benefited by the gauge proposed on the roads leading from AbroSam to Watsons gate by improving the grade and shortening the distance. Second the establishment of a road from Watsons gate to the Harrison County line is a connecting link between the first views, and the road proposed in Harrison County making a direct route from New Albin in Harrison County to Clusking belonging to the other County, shortening the distance one and one half miles between those two points. Third this view by a short cut of road disposed of a road running for Miles and yet a short distance from

We would respectfully report that the said Roads ought to be

for the following reasons: the other County road, and we further recommend that so much of the old road from Brookaws to Watsons gate as is not included in the present Survey be vacated, and we also recommend that all that part of the Plumtown Road from the Harrison County line to the Creek be vacated.

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such Roads shall be established thirty feet in width.
