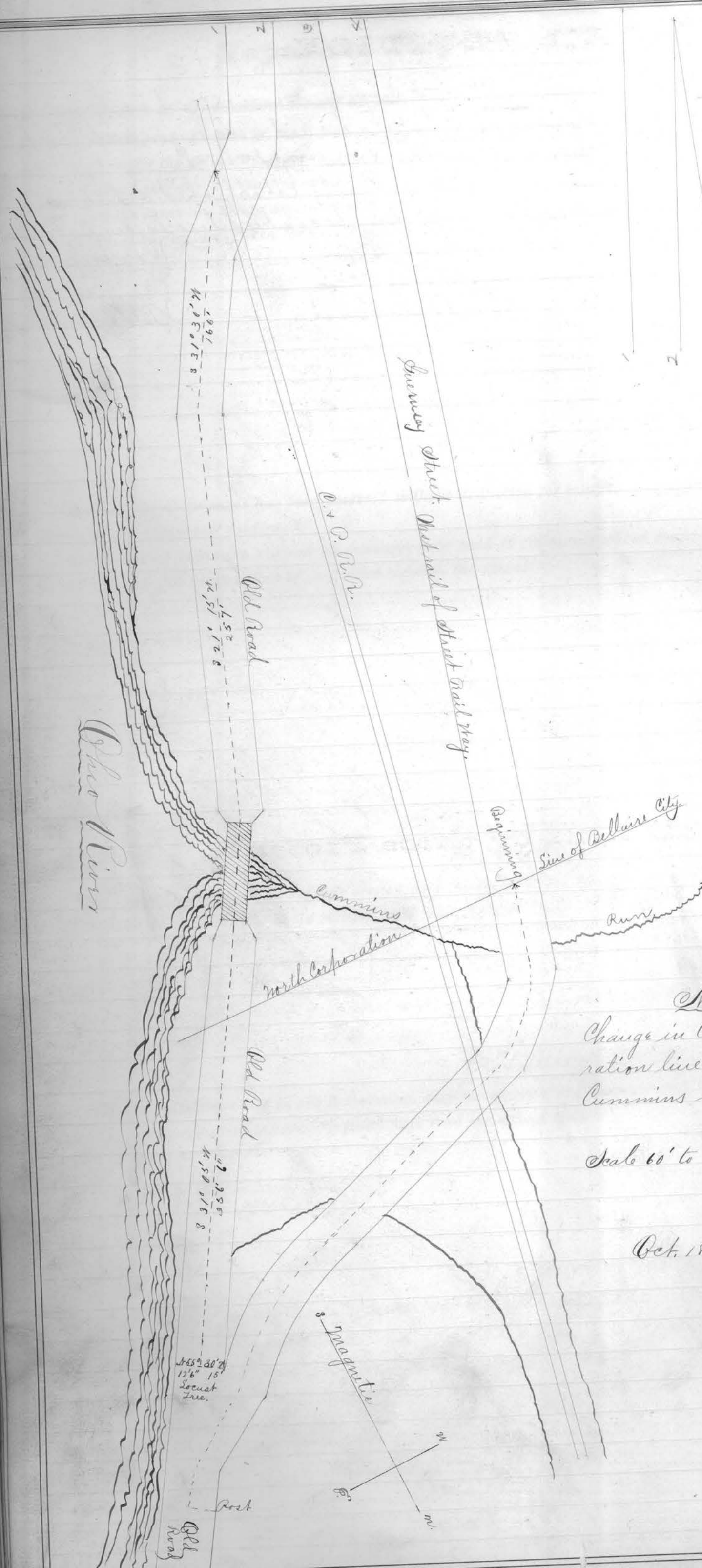

such road, to-wit: Beginning at the County Road leading from Shenect to Bellain in Pultney Township, Belmont County, Ohio, near a Bridge on the lands of Wm Thomas, in said Township thence in a northerly direction through the lands of said Thomas, and the lands of Mrs. Mary B. Alliman heirs of Jas. Dixon, decd. Jno. Sonley, Jno. A. Kiss, Sarah Tiffin, heirs of Wm Greuler, decd. to the lands of the heirs of Jno. McAllister, decd. thence in a north east direction, to a point near a gate on said McAllister's land. thence in a southeast direction to a point, near the line between said McAllister and Greuler lands, thence east to the top of the ridge to a point on or near said line, thence in a north east direction through the lands of said McAllister, to the lands of the heirs of Wm Greuler, decd. thence east through said Greuler land to a point near a beach tree on said lands, thence north easterly through the lands of the heirs of Jno. McAllister, decd. to the lands of Alva A. Kiss, thence south on the line between the lands of the heirs of Jno. McAllister, decd. on the one side and Alva A. Kiss and Jas. E. Kiss on the other side to a point, near the northeast corner of the said McAllister lands, thence in a north east direction through the lands of Jas. E. Kiss to a point near an apple tree on the County Road in Pultney Township, Belmont County, Ohio, leading from Bellain to the National Road, or as near thereto as a good road can be made, your petitioners therefore ask, that such proceedings may be had to establish such road, as may be authorized and directed by law.
