## Surveyor's Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated S 88 N 34.00 1883, proceeded, on the 26th day of March to survey and mark the County road described in said

order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

I proceeded from the Auditor's office the original report of the survey of the above mentioned County road surveyed in 1837 by William Shephard, in the notes of the survey referred to above there is no data given but bearings and distances with accuracy the line of the old survey, but which make it very difficult to determine as could be obtained, I made the survey and from said notes and such other testimony as could be obtained, I made the survey and caused the same to be marked by placing stakes at all angles, and by taking witness trees to them whenever such could be obtained in making the survey the reviewers directed some changes from the calls of the original notes one at Sta No 4 using S 75 N instead of S 85 N line between Station No 23 & 24 using 28.00 rods long instead of 20.00 at Sta No 27 S 82 1/4 N 7 rods instead of S 88 N 40.00 16 rods \* at Sta No 25 27 added a line S 43 N 12.30 rods long, the balance of the calls are the same as in the original notes and are as shown upon the flatamento annexed.

# REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your March session, A. D. 1883, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Caleb Dawson Surveyor, at Bellaine on March 26<sup>th</sup> 1883 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order. Bellaine March 26<sup>th</sup> 1883. With the viewers appointed by the County Commissioners at their March term to review and mark the County road described within and petitioned for by the Trustees of Putney Township met at Bellaine as directed with Caleb Dawson as Surveyor and and took the oath as required by law, but on account of the inclement weather adjourned to meet at least end of said road about 4<sup>th</sup> at 10 o'clock A.M. James Dunfer, Wallis McAllister, Alva A. Wise, Caleb Dawson and William Lucas were selected by us as chain carriers, and George Keyser as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view, said proposed line of said road from \_\_\_\_\_ on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the \_\_\_\_\_ of said road as follows:

The original notes of said road now on record in the Auditor's office, and from such other testimony as we could obtain, and cause the same to be surveyed and marked as directed, for further information in regard to the line we refer you to the surveyor's report accompanying this report. We find a great deal of difficulty from the meager notes of the original survey, and the length of time since said road was surveyed, in definitely locating the line of said road. And we might further report that we find that but a small part of the road as now used is upon the line of the original survey, and that in many places the old survey would be no improvement upon the present line, as now used which in many places is also very much damaged by landowners putting up fences so as to crowd the travel on the banks, or in the creek.

## Surveyor's Report.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated March 6<sup>th</sup> 1883, proceeded, on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of March to survey and mark the location of a County road described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

Having procured the notes of the original survey made by Thomas Mitchell in 1859 as surveyor and recorded in Plat Book No. 3 page 2425. The notes give nothing but bearings and distances except at Station No. 1 the beginning of the road line from which an Elm tree standing on south bank of McNaughans Run bears S 40° E 86 1/2 links which I find standing from which the beginning road can be located with a certainty from which I commence the resurvey of said road line according to said notes with a variation of 2° N. Taking witness trees and other objects to mark the angles in said road line whenever they could be conveniently obtained, no line the length of this with nothing but magnetic bearings can be exactly retraced. In order to make the present survey agree with the old one, the reviewers directed some changes from the notes of the original notes to be made. One at Sta. No. 10 making the bearing of line S 30° E instead of S 27° E. line from Sta. No. 28 to 29 make 26.7 rods instead of 24.7 rods. line between Sta. 35 & 36 make 15 rods instead of 13.0 rods. the balance as in the original notes and are so ploughed upon the flat hensaults. At Sta. No. 1 the N.E. Cor. of the south abutment of the Hegge Pike run bears S 40° E 8.53 rods. Sta. No. 4 a large Sycamore bears Bridge across McNaughans Run 3.88 rods. Sta. No. 5 a Willow 15 in diam bears N 33° E 2.56 rods. Sta. No. 7 a Stake on quarter section line. Sta. No. 8. S 7° E of Littleton's house bears N 39° E 1.13 rods. Sta. No. 9 a Sycamore 1 foot diam. bears S 41° E 1.48 rods dist. Sta. No. 10 from which a stone planted for Patterson's S.E. Cor. bears S 37° N. 4.57 rods. Sta. No. 11 a Locust 6 in diam bears N 20° N. 1.56 rods. Sta. No. 13 from which an Elm 2 feet in diam. bears S 79° E 1.96 rods. Sta. No. 18 from which an Elm 10 in diam bears S 11° E. 3.04 rods dist. Sta. No. 26 from which a Locust 8 in diam bears N 24° N. 6.238 rods dist. an Elm 18 in diam bears S 63° E. 1.96 rods. Sta. No. 36 a White Oak 20 in diam. bears S 45° N. 7 links dist. Sta. No. 39 a Locust 10 in diam. bears N 40° E 24 links dist. and a White Oak 30 in diam bears S 69° N. 57 links dist.
