The undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated with 29<sup>th</sup> Decr 1888, proceeded, on the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April to survey and mark the Alteration of the Dillies Bottom <sup>2<sup>nd</sup> St. Road</sup> Thompson described in said order, under the direction of the Viewers therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey:

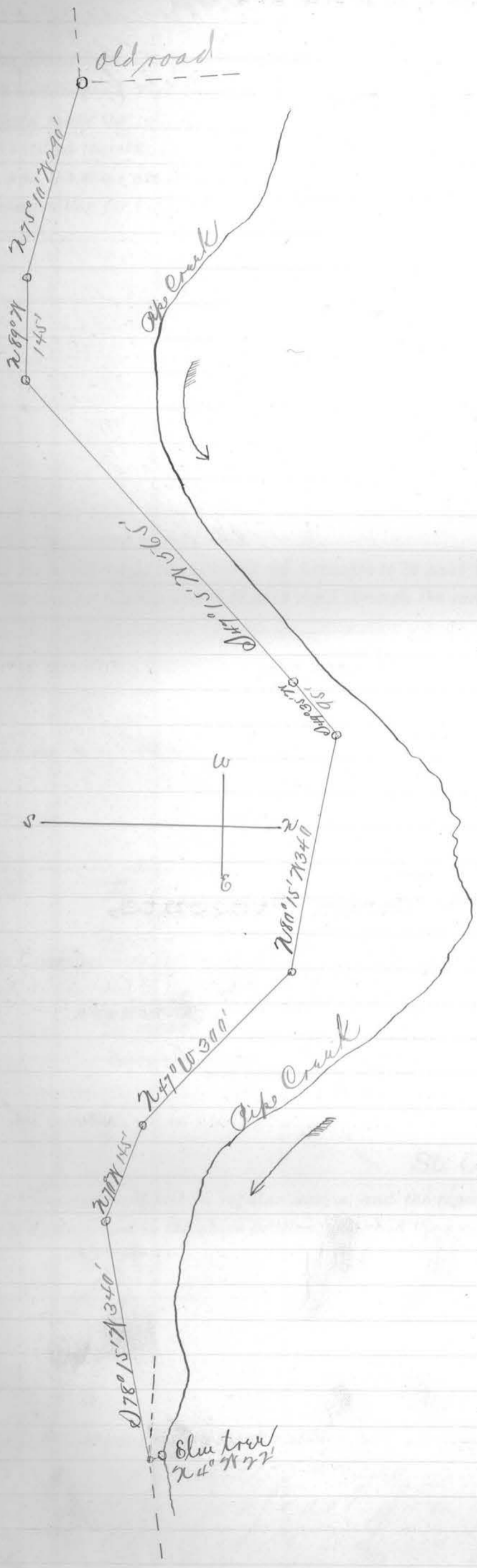

 \$60<sup>00</sup> Compensation; To Jacob W Acton \$187<sup>00</sup> Compensation  
 To James L Deal \$400<sup>00</sup> Compensation and \$300<sup>00</sup> damages,  
 is just and reasonable; but that said road is not  
 of sufficient importance to the public to warrant the pay-  
 ment of said compensation and damages out of the  
 County Treasury, it is ordered that the petitioners pay  
 or tender to pay, the several claimants, forthwith, two-  
 thirds of the amount of compensation and damages so  
 as aforesaid assessed to them, as follows:

To Jno. Mausfield \$266<sup>66</sup><sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> Compensation; To Wash. Buchanan  
 \$40<sup>00</sup> Compensation; To Jacob W. Acton \$124<sup>66</sup><sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> Compensation; To James L  
 Deal \$266<sup>66</sup><sup>2</sup>/<sub>3</sub> compensation, and \$200<sup>00</sup> damages, and that  
 no further proceedings be had in the premises, until  
 such payment or tender shall have been made.
