The Conditions of the above Obligations are such, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the location of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Begining in the township road near a small ravine on the lands of James Brown in Washington Township, Belmont County, Ohio, thence through the lands of James Brown, Wesley Carpenter, J. S. Davis, T. J. Pugh to the residence of said T. J. Pugh. Thence in a south westerly direction through the lands of said T. J. Pugh and Ivy Hoffmeyer to the place of termination in the County road leading from Beallsville to Arushing Mills.

Now if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.
