Your petitioners, resident electors of said County of Belmont and residing in the vicinity of the County road established about the year AD 1840, leading from Gates run in York Township to the main road leading from the mouth of Capluna Creek to Woodfield in Monroe County. This, said road when established was designated as commencing at or near Boger's mill on said Gates Run, thence through the lands of said Boger, Henry Gates, Nelson Malloy and Peter Anshutz, so as to intersect the County road aforesaid; your petitioners therefore ask that your Hon. Board grant a re-survey and location of said road aforesaid, as the Statute in such case made and provided directs, for which we as bound will ever pray.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your April session, A. D. 1895, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with Jno A Bond Surveyor, at Near residence of J. Schuegg on the 30th day of Aug 1895 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

Geo W Green Jr and Henry Newhart were selected by us as chain carriers, and Edward Boger as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed ~~on the line~~ on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the _____ of said road as follows:

and proceeded to view and survey and lay out said proposed road on the line of old road as now traveled, commencing at or near Bogers mills on said Gates run in York P Belmont Co. O. thence to the main ridge road run thence through the lands of Lewis Boger, Jacob Schuegg, Jacob Jenuewin, Lewis Boger and Jacob Jenuewin to intersect the county road leading from Captina creek to Woodfield, O. We would respectfully report that our opinion is that the said road ought to be established for the following reasons: First: School purposes and for the convenience of the General public. We have also determined that the public convenience requires that said road shall be established and opened 30 feet in width, No compensation and no damages.

The Commissioners met in regular session, and, after reading the petition of Jacob Jennewein, et al, it appeared that the the place of beginning or true course of the road leading from Gates Run in York Tp to the main ridge road leading from the mouth of Captina Creek to Woodsfield, O., is uncertain, It is therefore ordered that Isaac Ramsey Sr, J. C. Embelake and Saml Myers, three disinterested freeholders of the County, be, and they hereby are appointed to review and find the place of beginning and true course of said road; John A. Bond is appointed Surveyor and said appointees are directed to proceed, after being duly sworn to view and survey said road, and to meet at Jacob Schuepp's ^{on the 9th day of May 1895} and to correctly mark throughout, as in the case of a new road and to make a return of the survey and plat of the road to this board at its June session 1895, and that the County Auditor issue to them, in the name of the board, the necessary order, to wit:

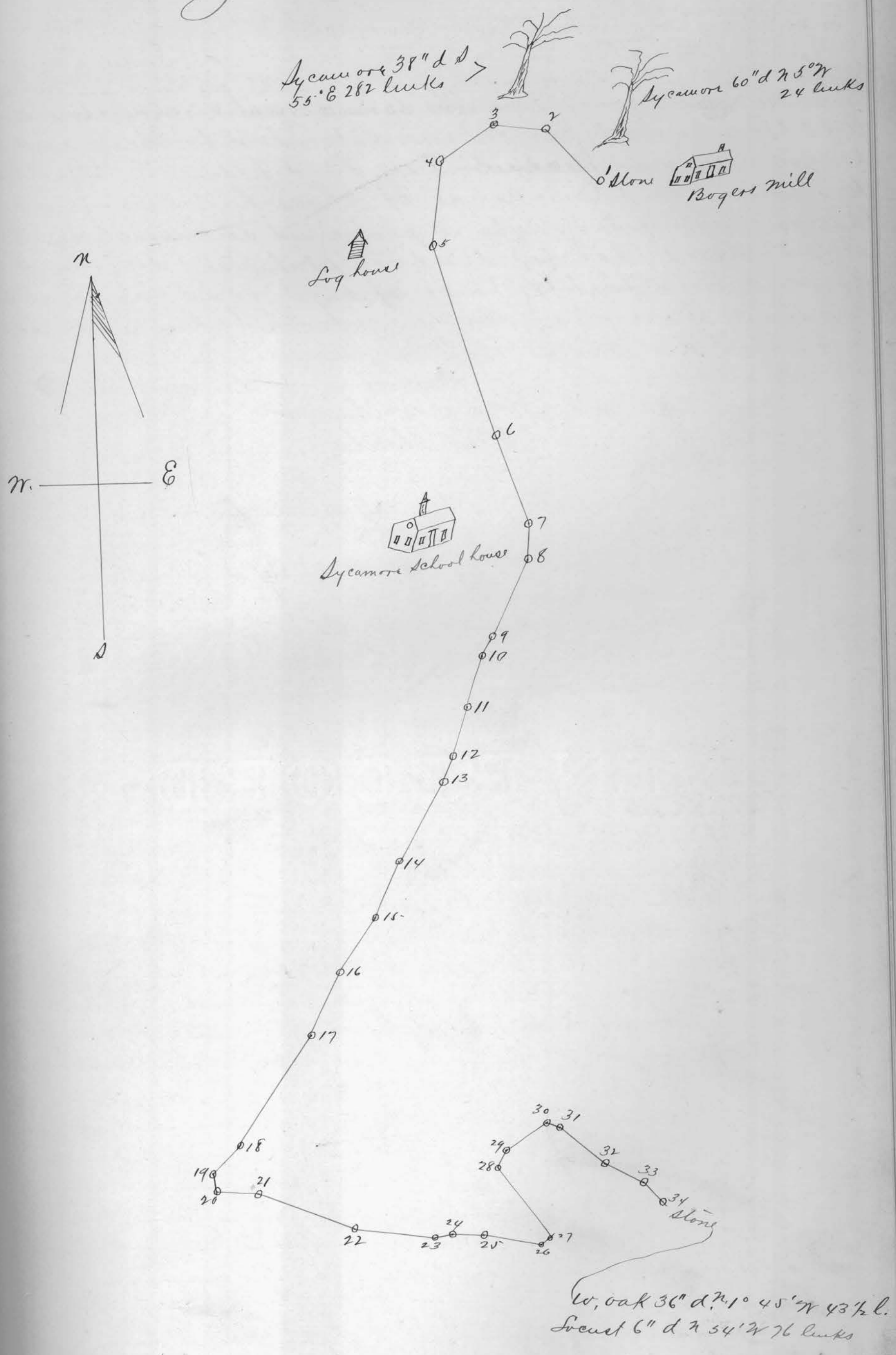

ROAD PETITION,

For Vacation of County Road in York Tp

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County respectfully represent that the public convenience requires that the present road connecting the County road leading from Powhatan Point Belmont County, Ohio, to the town of Bealsville, Monroe Co., Ohio intersecting the County road leading to the town of Bealsville and Woodsfield, Ohio on the ridge be vacated or that portion of the road on the line hereinafter described: and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to vacate portion of said road to-wit: Beginning at the present School House in Section No 19 Township 4 of Range 3 on the lands of Jacob Schuegg and Lewis Boger Jr. thence over and through the lands of Jacob Schuegg a westerly course up the hill to the lands of Jacob Juncowin; thence over and through the lands of Jacob Juncowin in Section No. 19 up the in a southerly direction to a point on the summit of the hill where said road intersects the county road leading out on the Armann ridge to the Monroe and Belmont County line, for the following reasons: The grade is too high, and the road district is sparsely populated, and there is two roads leading from the same County road running up Gales run to Bealsville, Monroe Co. not over 1 miles distant and running up the hill in Monroe County which road is no benefit to the people of Belmont County and being so sparsely populated, there is not sufficient labor in said district No. 8 to keep up so many roads running parallel with each other into Switzer land townships in Monroe County and we would furthermore represent that said road to be vacate, there is no record showing that said road was ever surveyed and duly established, and for the vacation of said road your humble petitioners will ever pray
