To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

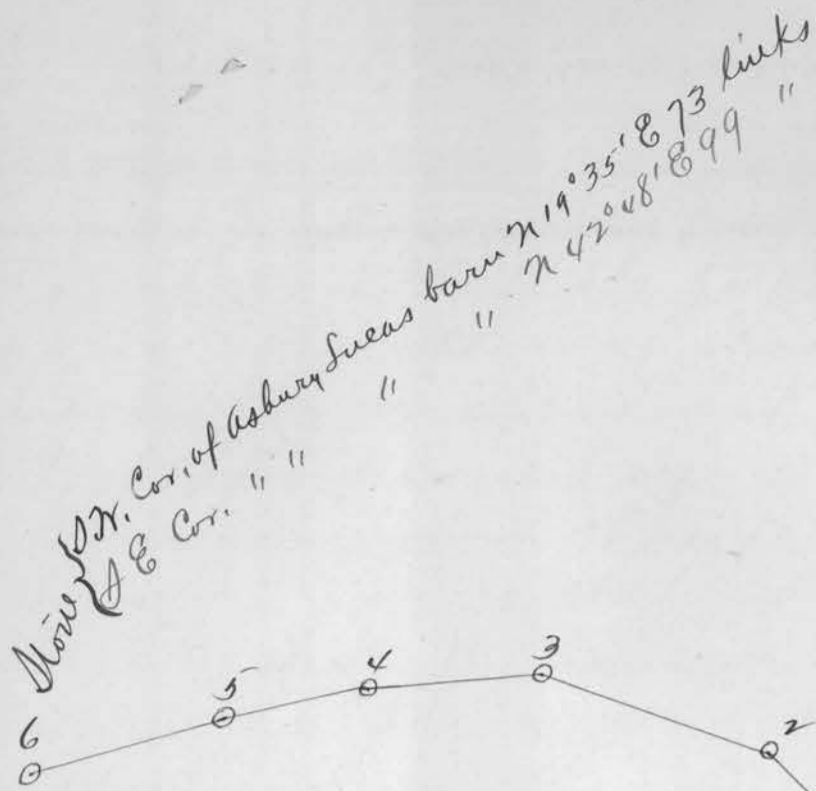
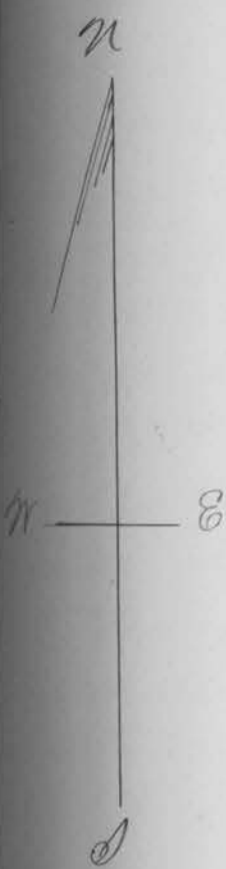

# ROAD PETITION,

For Alteration of County Road in York Tp

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

The undersigned petitioners, resident freeholders of said County, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the survey and alteration of a county road on the line hereinafter described, and pray that your body will institute and order the proper proceedings in the premises to have a survey, alteration and change of grade in such road to-wit: Beginning at a stake south of residence of Michael Dorsey, in York Tp Belmont Co, Ohio on the Steuben and Marietta State road on the lands of the heirs of G W Woods, thence southwest through said lands to a stake; thence northwest through said lands to a stake intersecting the German Hill road, thence with said road to a thorn bush on the north side of said road on the lands of Wm Brill, thence south west through said lands to the north of said German Hill road to the foot of first bluff, thence south west along said road to the top of said bluff, thence south west through the lands of Wm Brill to the north of said road near to the foot of next bluff in said road, thence south west along said road to an old stable in the lands of the heirs of G W Woods, thence south of said road and running south west through the lands of the heirs of G W Woods and intersecting said German Hill road at the foot of the next bluff, thence west with said road to an untenanted dwelling house on the lands of James Abriqg west through said lands to the south of German Hill road to the corner of a garden near the residence of James Aberiggs, thence west with said road to the residence of Frederick Rausser, thence west through the lands of Frederick Rausser to the south of said German Hill road intersecting said road at the Monroe County line

The Conditions of the above Obligations are such, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the Alteration of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Commencing at a point south of Michael Dorsey's on what is known as the Steubenville & Marietta State road and intersecting the road known as the German Hill road and following the same with some alterations mentioned in petition to the Monroe County line.

Now if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

The Commissioners met in Monthly session at their office, and the Board being satisfied that the foregoing petition was signed by at least twelve freeholders of the county, residing in the vicinity of the Alteration of said county road, and that the proper notices had been given according to law, bond filed, approved and accepted, thereupon the Board appointed David Brown Phillip Fraley & M E Moore three disinterested freeholders of the county, viewers, and Jno A Bond surveyor of said proposed road, to meet at Fishes Hotel, Poughlaton Nov 19 1895 at 10 a. m for the purpose of discharging their official duties relative to the object prayed for in the foregoing petition. And the Auditor is authorized to notify all non-resident landowners by publication, as required by law.
