St. Clairsville Ohio June 6th 1899

A difference of opinion having arisen between the Trustees of Colrain Tp and the Officials of the C. L & W. R.R. in regard to crossing the line of said R.R. by the County road petitioned for by M.C. Edwards Etal and established by order of the commissioners Sept 9th 1897, and said difference having been adjusted by concurrence of the R.R. Officials, Township Trustees, and County Commissioners, in accepting a strip of land dedicated by John Scott for road purposes. It is therefore ordered by the Board that the land dedicated by John Scott be accepted as roadway and that the Auditor be authorized to issue his warrant for \$30^c to said Scott in payment for said strip of land, upon the opening of the road through his lands, and it is further ordered that the dedication be placed upon the Road Record of Belmont Co. C Commissioners Journal No 6. P 376.



ROAD PETITION,

For Alteration of County Road in Smith & Richland Tps
At Clarendon Sept 7-1897

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

You petitioners undersigned freeholders of said County residing in the vicinity of the alteration hereinafter described respectfully represent that the public utility and convenience demand the alteration of a County Road leading up McMahons Creek bottom from the village of Glencoe in said County to Wainoock Station in said County on the following line to wit

Beginning in the said County Road at a point on the lands of Elizabeth Fulton, where the Powell Hill Road intersects said road; thence in a southwesterly direction across McMahons Creek and lands of Geo T Fulton to the right of way of The Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road^{Company}; thence in a southwesterly direction across the right of way of the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road Company and through the lands of Geo T Fulton between the house and wagon shed on said lands to the south bank of McMahons Creek; thence along said Creek bank to a ravine, between the lands of Geo T Fulton and James & John M Wainoock; thence across said ravine on to the lands of James & John M Wainoock; thence in a westerly direction through the lands of James & John M Wainoock and the lands of John M & Samuel B Wainoock south of the farm on the lands of John M & S B Wainoock to the Jacobsburg & Wainoock Road near a tenant house on the said lands of John M & Samuel B Wainoock; thence along the said Jacobsburg & Wainoock Road to the intersection of the said McMahons Creek Road near Mt Olive School House; thence following the line of the said McMahons Creek Road to a point on said road near a ravine west of the residence of C Starkey; thence in a westerly direction through the lands of C Starkey and Isaac Ault between the present line of the said McMahons Creek Road and McMahons Creek to intersect the present line of the said McMahons Creek Road at a point in said road near a tenant house on the said lands of Isaac Ault.

The Conditions of the above Obligations are such, That whereas application has been made to the Board of Commissioners of said Belmont County for the location of a County road on the following line, to-wit:

Beginning in the said County Road at a point in the lands of Elizabeth E. Fulton where the Powell Hill Road intersects said Road; thence in a south westerly direction, across McMahons Creek and the lands of George T. Fulton to the right of way of The Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road Company thence in a south westerly direction, across the right of way of the Baltimore & Ohio Rail Road Co. and through the lands of George T. Fulton, between the house and wagon shed on said lands to the South Bank of McMahons Creek thence along said creek bank to a ravine, between the lands of George T. Fulton and James and John M. Warnock; thence across said ravine on to the lands of James and John M. Warnock; thence in a westerly direction, through the lands of James and John M. Warnock and the lands of John M. and Samuel B. Warnock South of the barn on the lands of John M. & S.B. Warnock to the Jacobsburg and Warnock Road near a tenant house on the said lands of John M. and Samuel B. Warnock; thence along the said Jacobsburg and Warnock Road to the intersection of the said McMahons Creek Road near "Mount Olive" School House; thence following the line of the said McMahons Creek Road, to a point on said road near to a ravine west of the residence of C. REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your Sept 7 session, A. D. 1897, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with John A. Bond Surveyor, at Marbletown on Oct 28th 1897 and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

If any viewer is unable to attend, his place will be supplied by another who will fill the vacancy.

Jos Workman and Jos Denham were selected by us as chain carriers, and Geo Lambert as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:
