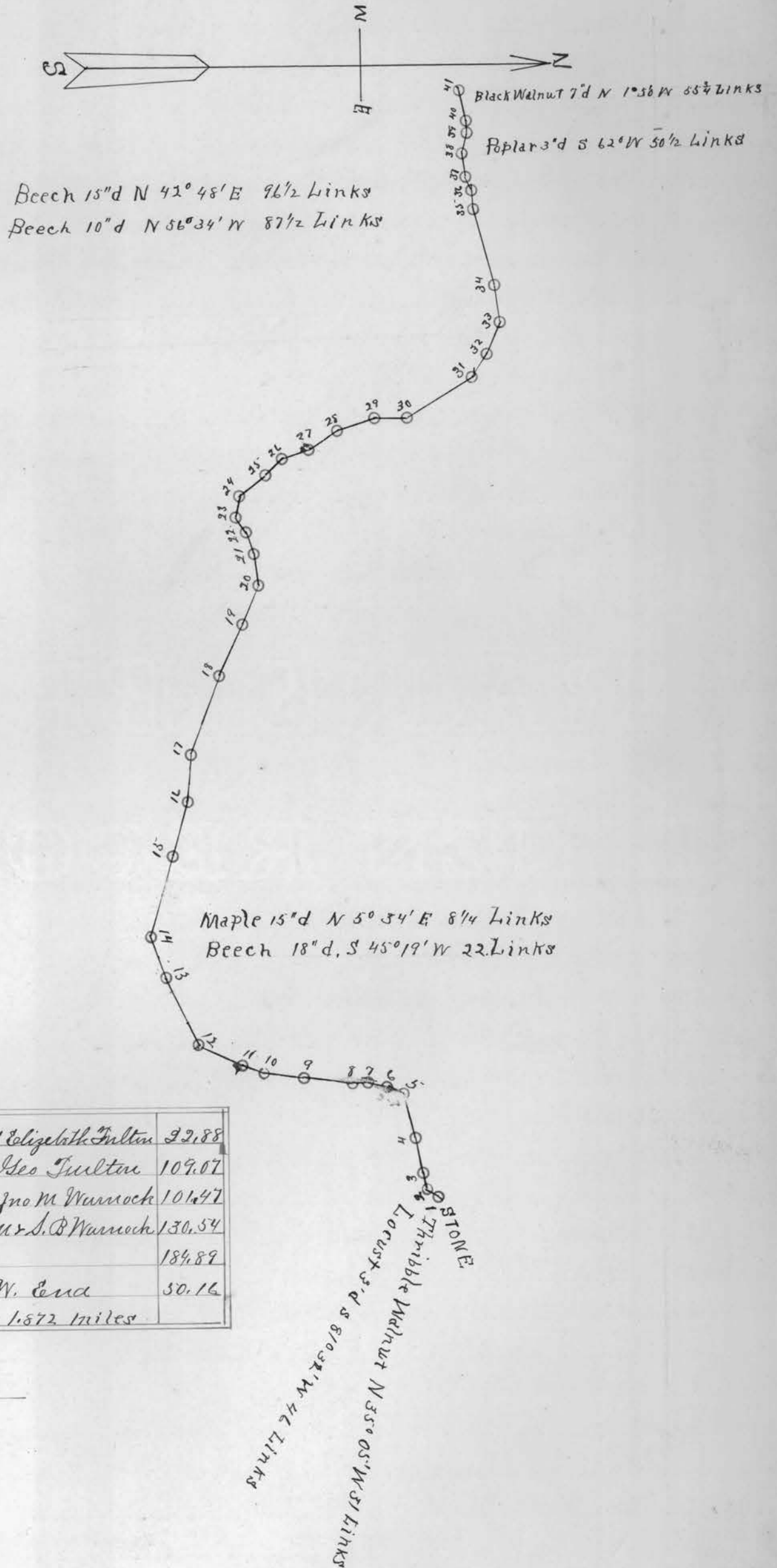

We the Trustees of Mead Township in said County respectfully report that upon the Petition of August Kenemund & et al residents of said Township they took to their aid Sarah Nicholl as Surveyor (who was duly sworn to discharge the duties of his appointment and on the 25 day of may 1897 it being the day fixed by them to commence for that purpose) & continued and completed the same on the 28th day of may 1897. They proceeded to examine a County Road leading from Pultney Bottom to Jacobsburg via Mezer Creek, through said Trps which had been injured on the lands of J E McMillen Joseph Thompson John Pelky Lettia McKinley Michael Feeney J H Hepburn Heirs of Dixon Meyers and Robert Braunen by the washing out of road (by the July flood of 1896) and being of the opinion upon examination that said Road has been so much damaged at the places mentioned that the public good requires a change of same. They thereupon laid out and surveyed eleven alterations on said road along the following described route as shown by Surveyors report here into attached. Whereby said road is placed upon better and safer grounds than before

We the undersigned Trustees as viewers to lay out said road and to assess the compensation & damages resulting by reason of alteration of said road report as to said damage that we having carefully examined the route of said road over the premises we award compensation to the Claimants mentioned below for the property sought to be appropriated as follows.

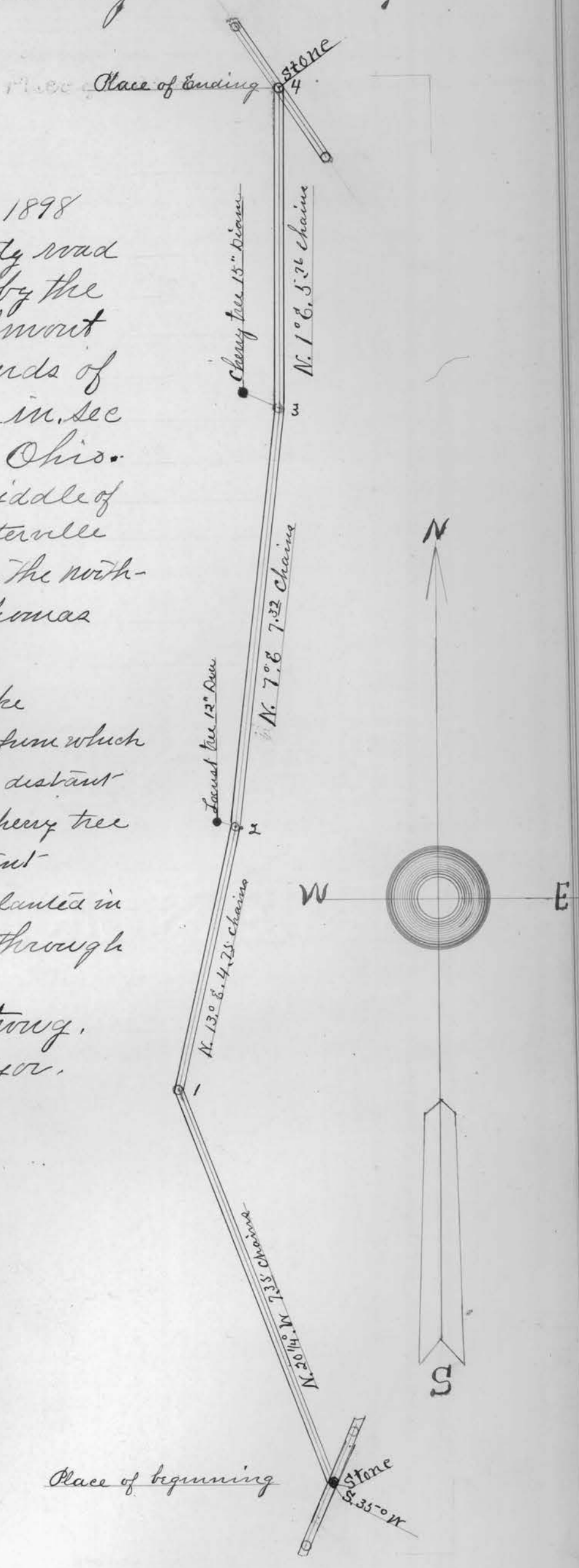
