



Now if the said applicants shall pay into the Treasury of the said county the amount of all costs and expenses
accruing thereon, in case the prayer of said petitioners shall not be granted, or when the proceedings had in pursuance
thereof shall not be finally confirmed and established, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be in full force in law.

The following is the arrangement between the Commissioners and Denham Heirs:

In the matter of the McMahons Creek and StClairsville Road closed by the building of the road up McMahons Creek, Elizabeth Denham, W D Denham and P J Denham. Heirs of William Denham, having granted to the Commissioners of Belmont County (for the consideration of \$100^{#3/4}) One Hundred Dollars a roadway 30 ft wide through their premises, as surveyed by Isiah Nichols Aug 22nd 1898 and no objection having been made it is ordered that said strip of land be and the same is hereby accepted as a part of said County Road, and that all the papers in the case and the plat and survey be recorded in the Road book of Belmont County




