

ROAD PETITION,

For VACATION OF PART OF Road in WARREN TOWNSHIP

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

We, the undersigned, freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the within described road, sought to be vacated, respectfully petition that you cause to be vacated the part of the road in Warren Township, Belmont County, beginning at the new Leatherwood free turnpike at a point about 77 feet from the bridge near the home of John Forbes, running thence, northeasterly 280 feet and being part of the old County road not macadamized in the construction of said free turnpike, owing to a change of direction in this vicinity; and we further petition that the remainder of said portion of the County road not so macadamized and leading from the end of the above described piece easterly to the road dedicated by Forbes be allowed to remain open for the convenience of the neighborhood and that the remainder of said road eastward to the free turnpike be vacated.



Beginning in a public road, leading from Glencoe to St. Clairsville opposite the south-east corner of the yard around the residence of the late Robert Garlile, deceased, and on the south side of a fence to a small walnut tree on the west-side of the run; thence, in a north-easterly direction, to the north-west corner of the land of the heirs of John P. Neff, and the south line of Robert Garrett's land; thence in a north-easterly direction through the lands of Robert Garrett, to the public road, known as The St. Clairsville and Dillies Bottom Road, near a white oak tree on the west side of said road.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

In obedience to your order, issued at your Sept 6th session, A. D. 1898, we the undersigned, Viewers appointed under said order, met with John A. Bond Surveyor, at Glencoe on Sept 27th and were severally sworn to discharge, faithfully and impartially, the duties required of us in said order.

If any viewer is unable to attend, he may be excused in the vacancy was filled.

James Wiley and Charles Haines were selected by us as chain carriers, and J E Ferrell as a marker, who were also duly sworn.

We then proceeded to view said proposed County Road on the line described in your order, and caused the same to be surveyed, "as prayed for in the petition, or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expense, taking into consideration the utility, convenience, and inconvenience and expense which will result to individuals as well as the public," by the Establishment of said road as follows:

Beginning for said survey at a stone planted in the middle of the public road leading from Glencoe to St. Albansville thence N 78° 30' E 1619.47 feet through the lands of Robert Carlile deceased to sta No 2, thence N 36° 47' E 294.50 feet to sta No 3, thence N 42° 47' E 137.83 feet to sta No 4, thence S 26° 30' E 120.33 feet to sta No 5, thence S. 1° 44' E 93 ft to sta No 6 thence N 60° 30' E 43.83 feet to sta No 7, thence N. 18° 41' E 232.16 feet to sta No 8, thence N. 00° 45' E 175 feet to sta No 9 thence N 10° 20' E 100.83 feet to sta No 10 thence N 22° 30' E 67.41 feet to sta No 11 thence N 24° 36' E 199 feet to sta No 12 thence N 66° 57' E 72.33 feet to a stone in the center of public road leading from St. Albansville to Dillies Bottom

We would respectfully report that the said County Road ought to be established for the following reasons:

There will be a much shorter distance by the proposed rout. from Glencoe to the County Road leading from Dillies Bottom to St. Albansville and the grades will be much lighter and the road will be of general public utility

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that such County Road shall be established 33 feet in width.





ROAD PETITION,

For Alteration of County Road in Richland, I.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

Petitioned for by J W Neff Et al

Your petitioner, John W Neff and the parties whose names appear below; petition the Commissioners of Belmont County to make alterations in the County road leading from Neff's siding to Jacob'sburg in said County as follows: commencing at or near Joel Pettitt's new house, in Section 22 R 3. T. 5, and thence, northwardly to a point on said County road near the old house of Joel Pettitt in said section 22. The desire of the petitioners is that said road may be changed so as to pass to the west side of Sand Hill school house lot, near the line of an old road formerly there and that the road formerly there, and that the road between the school lot and Pettitt's old house may be changed by first passing eastwardly of the road as it now is, and then westwardly around the large knoll in said road.

And said petitioners further ask for the vacation of a part of the said old road as now used, from Joel Pettitt's old house southwardly to a point near the north end of said school lot, for the reason that said part of the old road will not be needed if said alterations are made.

Your petitioners represent that said change is badly needed and will be for the benefit of the public.

Your petitioners ask that said road be established and graded and that land owners be allowed a reasonable compensation for damages by them sustained.
