


### Surveyor's Report


The undersigned, in obedience  
to your order, dated June 5<sup>th</sup> 1841 proceeded, on the 20<sup>th</sup>  
day of June to survey and mark the alteration of the  
road described in said order, under the direction  
of the viewers therein named, and respectfully submit  
the following return of said survey.

Beginning at the place mentioned in your order  
at station 1, in the plot there, N. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 6 poles to  
station 2. Thence N. 15 E. 28 poles to station 3, in the south  
side of Martins Ferry & Leodellain Free Turnpike road  
through lands of Thomas Mitchel. Thence N. 15 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 2 poles  
to station 4 North side of said Free Turnpike thence near  
the line between T. Mitchel and Gilard Brown. N. 38 E.  
12.52 poles to station 5. thence N. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 10 poles to station 6,  
thence N. 23 E. 10 poles to station 7, in the Glens Run Road

V. Cleavers and also for the alteration of a short piece of road leading from the old Mt Pleasant and Martinsville plank road, commencing at or near the stone quarry on Eli V. Cleavers land, running East to the creek near the old saw-mill dam intersecting the creek. Also for the vacation of the creek road from John Loyds stable to the iron Bridge. 


