To The Board of Commissioners of Belmont Co., Ohio, in obedience to your order issued at your December session A.D. 1873, We, the undersigned Viewers, Viewers appointed under said order met with Thomas Metzger Surveyor at Peace Hays on the 18th day 1873 and were severally sworn to do charge, faithfully and impartially the duties required of us in said order,

Thomas Metzger and Wm. Spurr were selected by us as chain carriers and — as marker, who were also duly sworn

We then proceeded to view said proposed Road on the line described in your order and cause the same to be surveyed as prayed for in the petition or as near the same as in our opinion a good road can be made at a reasonable expence taking into consideration the utility convenience, and incumbrance and expence which will result to individuals as well as to the by the establishment, of said road as follows.

Beginning for said Beginning point mentioned in the road petition for by J. B. Thacker and others on the lands of Isaac Hays on Little fork of Short Creek, said beginning is near the house of said Isaac Hays thence running according to the surveyor report herewith returned, which survey includes the county Road leading from Mt. Pleasant to Bustina mounds and such alteration in said road we believe will be a public benefit. Take the travel from from the face of the creek, and it is located entirely upon the bank, South side of said creek, and we would recommend the adoption of said road also we do locate as much of the old road as lies between said Mt. Pleasant & Gas Mounds road and the East boundary line of the Hays farm

We have also determined that the public convenience requires that said road shall be established 80 ft. in width all of which is respectfully submitted December 18th 1873
