

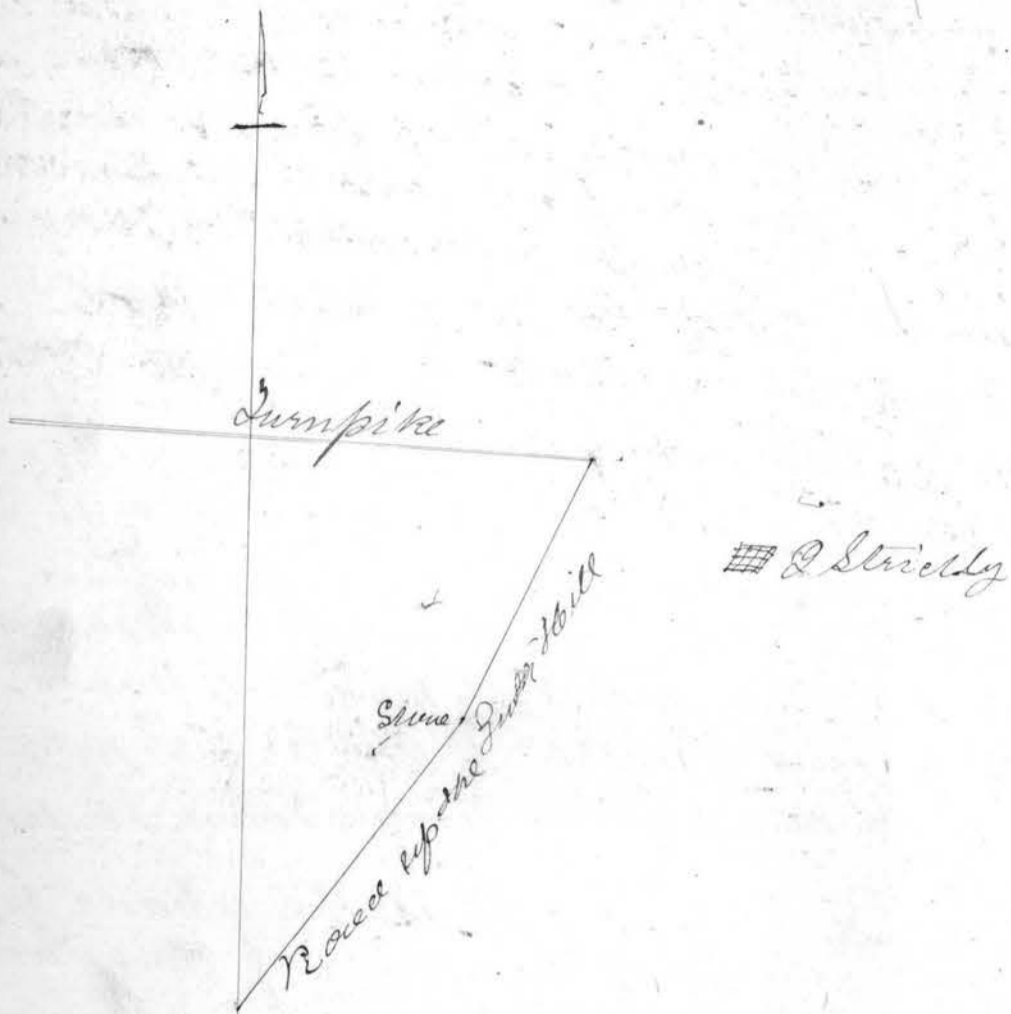

Strickley at a stake  $1\frac{1}{2}$  links east of a stone planted thence N.  $24^{\circ}$  E. 4 rods and 4 links, thence N.  $20^{\circ}$  E. 12 rods to a stake S.  $81^{\circ}$  E. 48 links so, as to include in the turnpike leading from Powhatan up Kopsline Creek. Whole distance 16 Rods 4 links.

The viewers met according to your order but Mr Owens being absent attending the funeral of his mother in law, the other two decided it illegal according to your order to fill the vacancy.

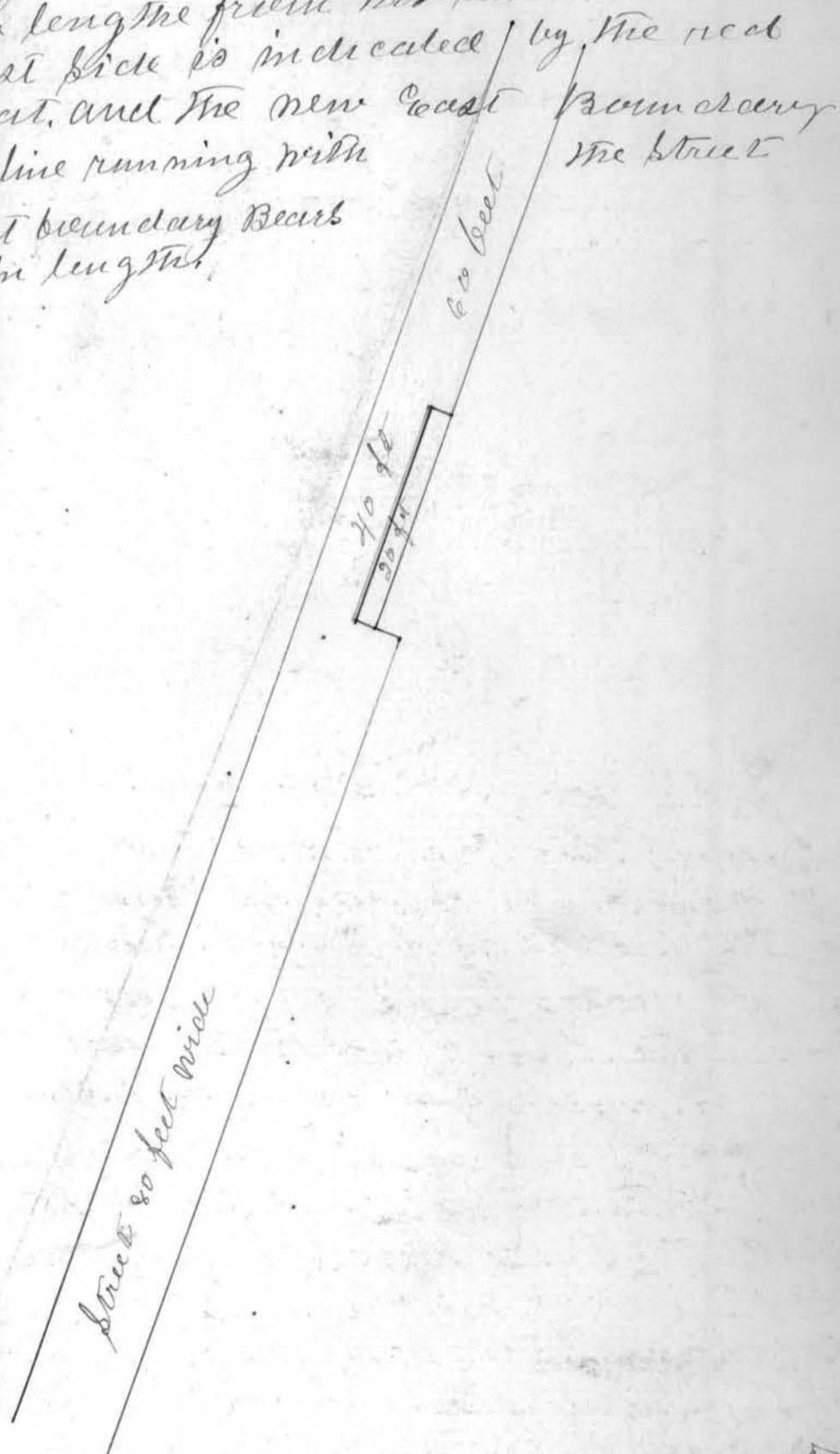

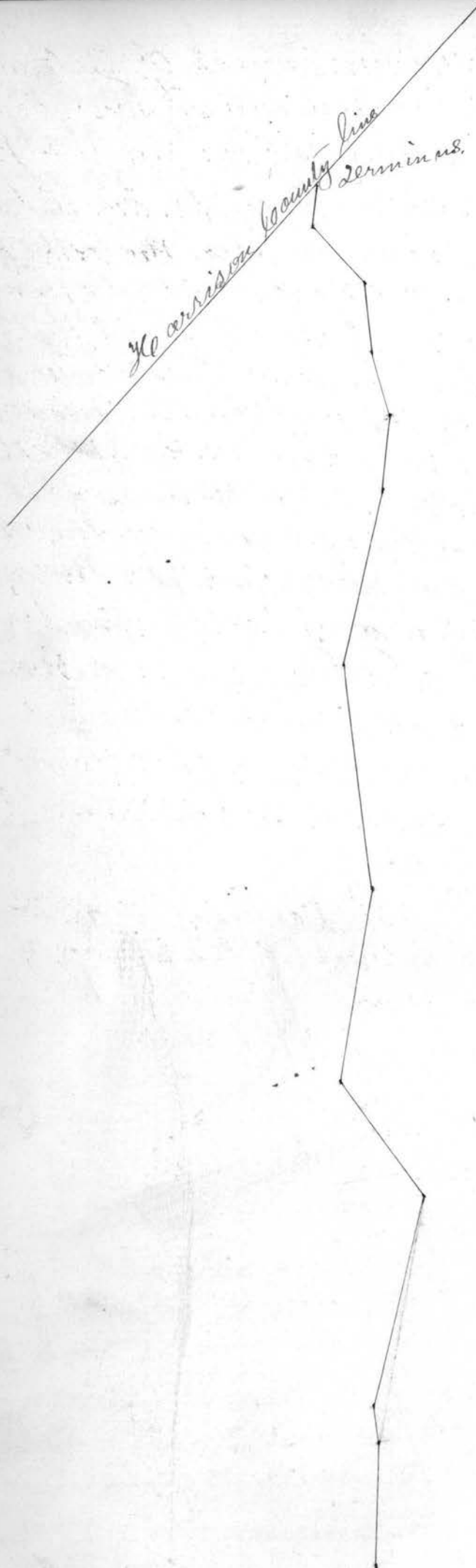

 Ohio the undersigned, in obedience to your order dated  
 March 1875 proceeded on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of April 1875  
 to Survey and mark the width of the road descri-  
 bed in said order, under the direction of the viewers  
 therein named, and respectfully submit the following  
 return of said Survey commencing on the south line  
 of Henry Harwoods land where the street is 80 feet  
 wide as indicated in the plat and in front of said  
 Henry Harwoods lots it is only 40 feet and immediately  
 above or N.E. it is 60 feet we made the road in front  
 of said Harwoods lots the same as the street above  
 making it 60 feet wide which took 20 feet wide  
 and 211 feet in length from his land the old Bound-  
 ary of the East side is indicated by the red  
 line in the plat, and the new East boundary  
 by the black line running with  
 above, the East boundary Bears  
 N45 $\frac{1}{2}$  E, 211 feet in length.

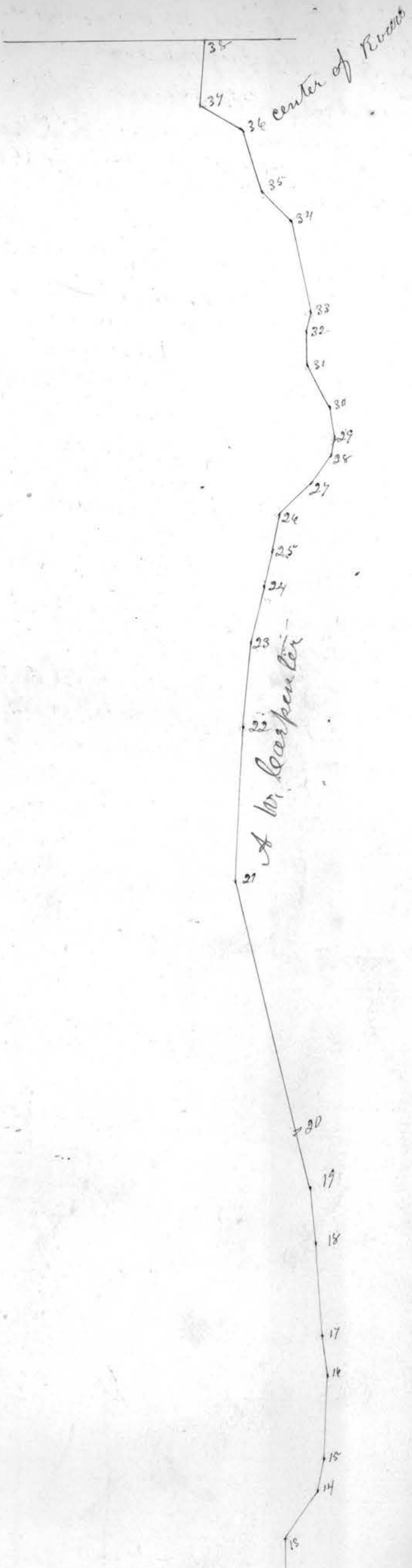

Ohio the undersigned, in obedience to your order, dated at your September first 1870 proceeded on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of September 1873 to survey and mark the County Road described in said order, under the direction of the owners therein named, and respectfully submits the following return of said survey, commencing at a stake in County Road near the corner of the lands of Jonathan Leash and Henry Leash, from which a Black Walnut bears S. 69° W. 32 feet and running thence as follows, N 17° E. 223 feet to a stake close to road, thence N 15½° E. 146 feet to a stake close to line, thence N 12½° E. 153 feet to a Black Walnut marked thence N 20° E. 225 feet to a White Walnut 10 in diameter marked N 1° E. 208 feet close to a Black Walnut, marked N 43½° W. 133 feet to a Sugar Tree, thence N 61¼° W. 231 feet to a stake, thence N 51¼° W. 120 feet to a stake on line between H. & J.
