For the Change and review of a Road in Pultney Township Township, Improvement No. 130 Petitioned for by Henry Eden and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the change and review of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at the Buckeye Bridge in Washington Township, Belmont County, Ohio, and running in a southerly direction up what is known as Clover Ridge to the Monroe County Line, Said road passing first through the lands of A. the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Henry Eden has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 18th day of July 1922, at 10.00 A. M., be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 14th day of August 1922, at 1.00 o'clock P. M., as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Bellaire Daily Leader a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

Pultney Twp.

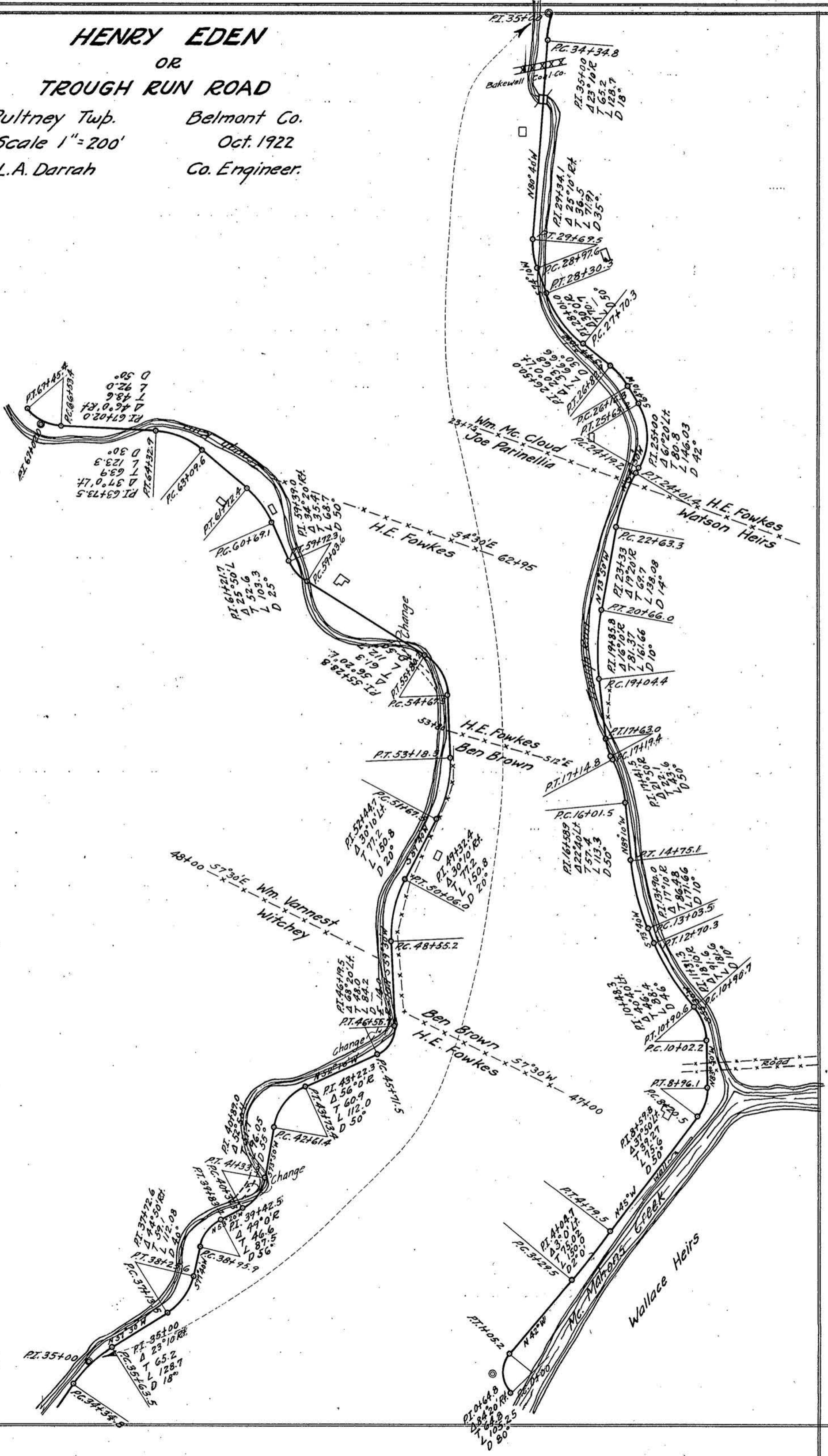

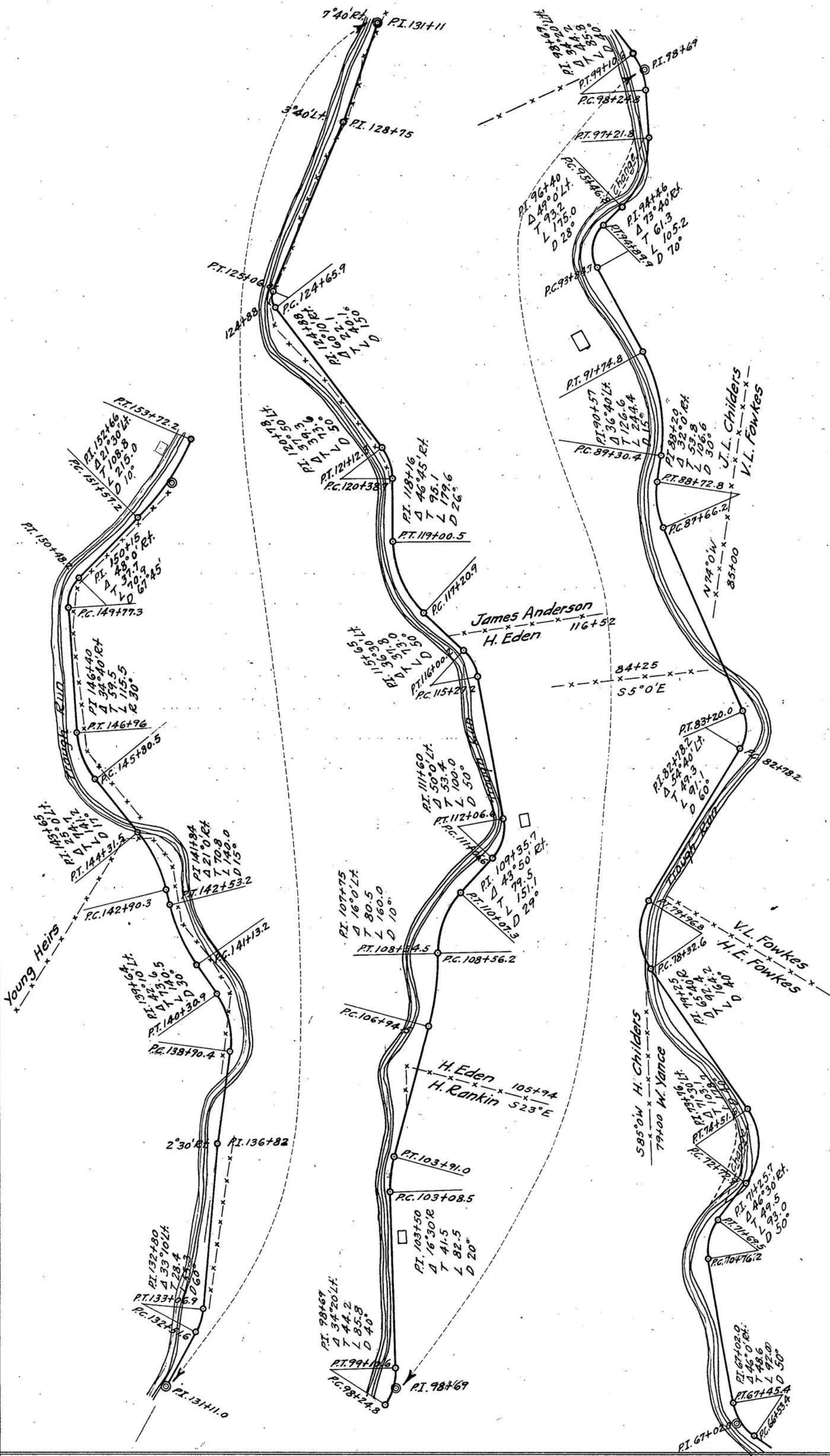
