Coleman and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by S. J. Coleman and others, in the Bellaire Daily Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 1st day of August 1922, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 11th day of September 1922, the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

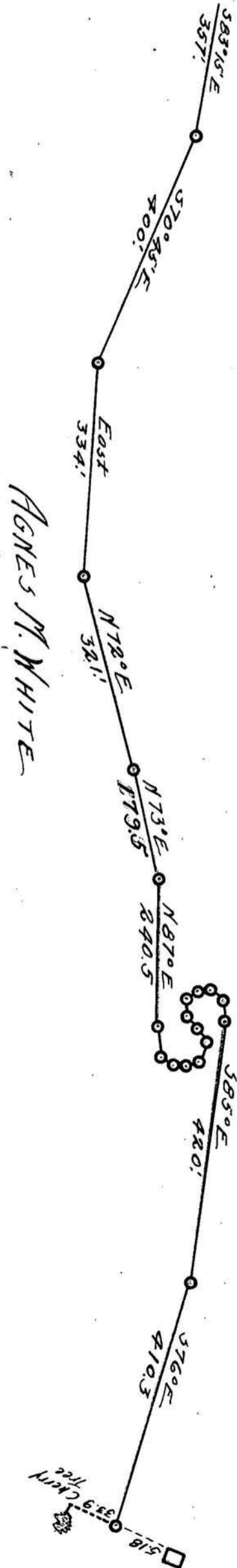
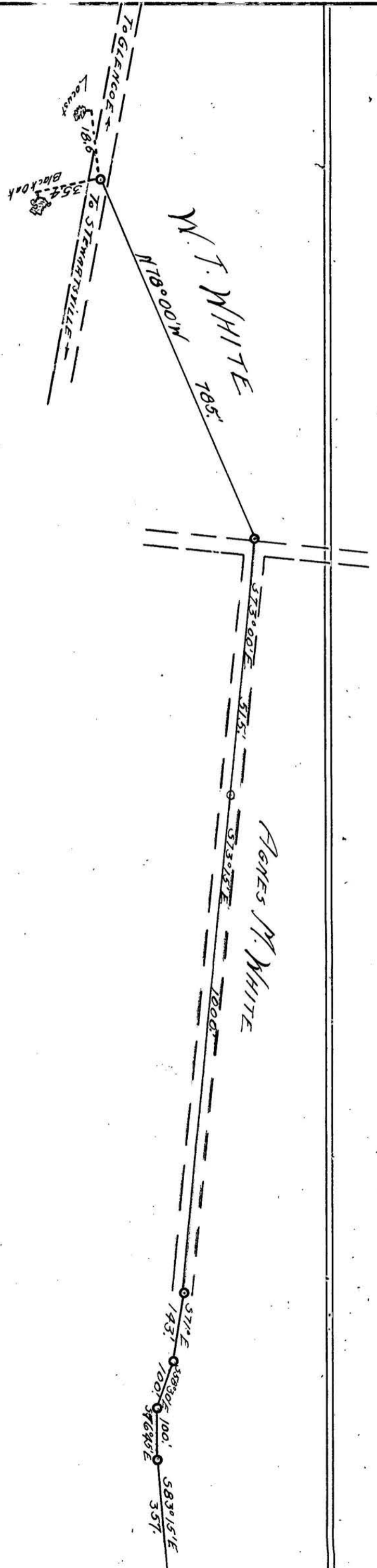

ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Goshen Township,
 Improvement No. 133 Petitioned for by Edwin Phillips and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at the eastern side of the public road leading from near Spiedel, Ohio, to the southern end of the pike or improved road leading south from the Village of Bethesda, Ohio; said beginning point being about 150 yards, in a northerly direction from the entrance of a private driveway leading from said public road into the residence and farm buildings belonging to Cash Heskett; thence leaving said point of beginning and going in an easterly direction through the lands of said Cash Heskett, Charles McKendree and Mrs. A. J. Mace to the lands belonging to Ruth Burns and the heirs of G. B. Burns, deceased; thence in an eastern direction, through the lands of said Ruth Burns and the heirs of J. B. Burns, deceased to an intersection with the pike or improved road leading in a southerly direction from the Village of Bethesda, Ohio; said intersection being at a point ^{see petition} about 200 feet, in a northerly direction, from the entrance to a private drive-way leading in an easterly direction from said Pike or Improved Road.
