Fogle, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the establishment of the public road, petitioned for by Edwin Phillips and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Edwin Phillips and others, in the Belmont Chronicle, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 25th day of July, 1922, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 14th day of August, 1922, the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

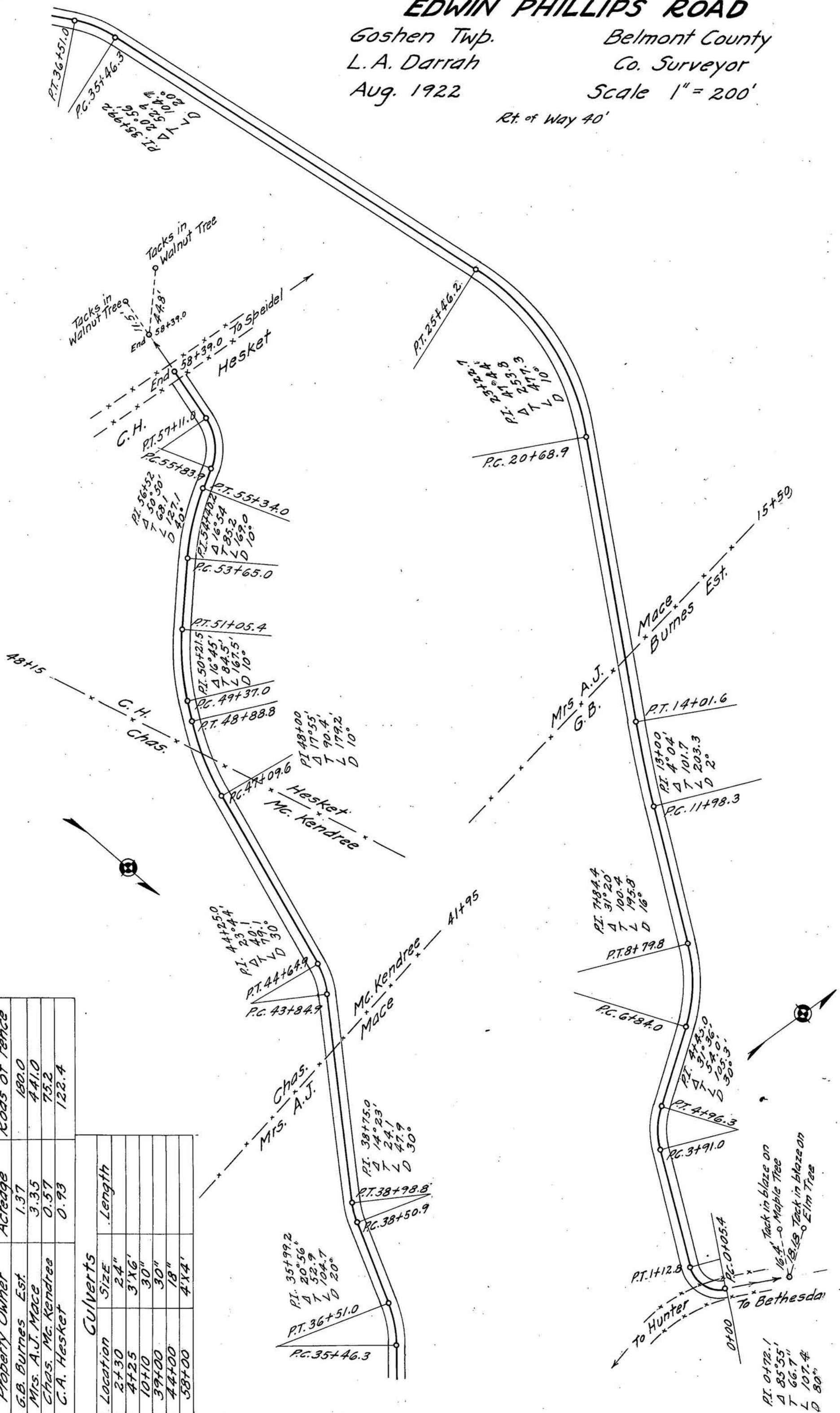
