Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

ROAD PETITION

For the Alteration, Straightening etc. of a Road in Richland Township,
 Improvement No. 136 Petitioned for by Louie Gabel and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration, straightening, etc. of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at forks of public road a short distance westerly from the residence of John Hoblick; thence in a southeasterly direction through the lands of John Hoblick to the public Road; thence following the line of said public road in a southerly direction through the lands of Louis Gable, Steven Chordas and Edward Filicky and The Lorain Coal & Dock Company Company to a point about One Hundred Feet North of the place where said public road turns in an easterly direction; thence through the lands of the said The Lorain Coal & Dock Company in a Southeasterly direction to an intersection with the public road about 100 feet in an easterly direction from the place where said road turns easterly; thence following the line of said public road in an easterly direction to the lands of James Benda; thence in an easterly direction, leaving the line of said public road, through the lands of James Benda, Thomas Freiburg, John Seifert, Thomas Freiburg, and the Maher Collieries Company to the intersection with the public road; thence following the line of said public road in an easterly direction under the mine tipple of Line No. 9 to The Maher-Collieries Company to the concrete Bridge over Little McLaughon's Creek; thence leaving the line of said public road going in an easterly direction about 100 feet South of the line of said public road to a broken concrete bridge and the line of the public road; thence following the line of said public road in a northerly direction to the intersection thereof with the right of way of The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company a short distance in a westerly direction from the residence of Joe Nowak.

All of said public road and the proposed alterations thereof is in Richland Township, Belmont County, Ohio.

Said Petitioners request that where said public road is to be widened or altered or straightened that the same be made not less than thirty feet in width.
