## ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Goshen Township,  
 Improvement No. 139 Petitioned for by G. N. Hollingsworth and Others.

**TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:**

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning for the same on the Barnesville and Bethesda road, a short distance east of the residence of Harry Hunt, and at or near where the present driveway leading to the farm of J. H. Hollingsworth intersects said Barnesville and Bethesda road, and running thence in a southeasterly direction across the farm usually know as the Rogers Farm and owned by Victoria Rogers to the lands of J. N. Hollingsworth and following substantially the present driveway across said farm; thence in a South-easterly direction across the lands of said G. N. Hollingsworth and east of his dwelling house and barn to intersect the old road at or near a bridge; thence still continuing over the lands of said G. N. Hollingsworth along the most practicable route to the South-west corner of A. D. Craigs land, said course being a general Southern course until reaching the lands of Rogers; thence east with the section line and over the lands of A. D. Craig to intersect the old road at or near a gate leading from said old road to the driveway to the residence of Lulu Patterson; thence with said old road to the improved highway leading south from Bethesda.

Also, beginning for the same at the South-east corner of the North-east quarter of Section 28 in said township and running thence South with the section line and the present roadway along the lands of H. H. Heskett, Victoria Rogers and Lulu Patterson, to the lands of Mrs. A. J. Mace; thence across the lands of said Mrs. A. J. Mace, along the most practicable route, to the dwelling or residence of said Mrs. A. J. Mace.
