The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the alteration of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning

At the east end of Anderson's garage located on the south side of the County Road leading from the Pultney Ridge Road west through a part of the southwest quarter of section 28 and the south part of section 34, of Township 8, Range 6, Belmont County, Ohio, to the Belmont & Guernsey Counties division line; thence in a south easterly direction and south of the present location of said road 70 rods to a beech tree; thence in a northeasterly direction and south of the present location of said road 72 rods to the junction of said roads with the said Pultney Ridge Road.

Finley, ~~Assistant~~ and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the alteration of the public road, petitioned for by Jacob Reischman and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Jacob Reischman and others, in the Barnesville Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 11th day of March 1924, ^{Con't, till April 15, 1924.} met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 7th day of April 1924, ^{Con't. till May 5, 1924.} the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

Pursuant to your order dated April 7, 1924, I make my report to you as follows, in the matter of the Alteration of the public road petitioned for by Jacob Reischman and others.

1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement; but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: is for the betterment of the county road system
2. The width should be 40 feet
3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a * before the name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

Should have 3-12" corrugated culverts put in when opened.

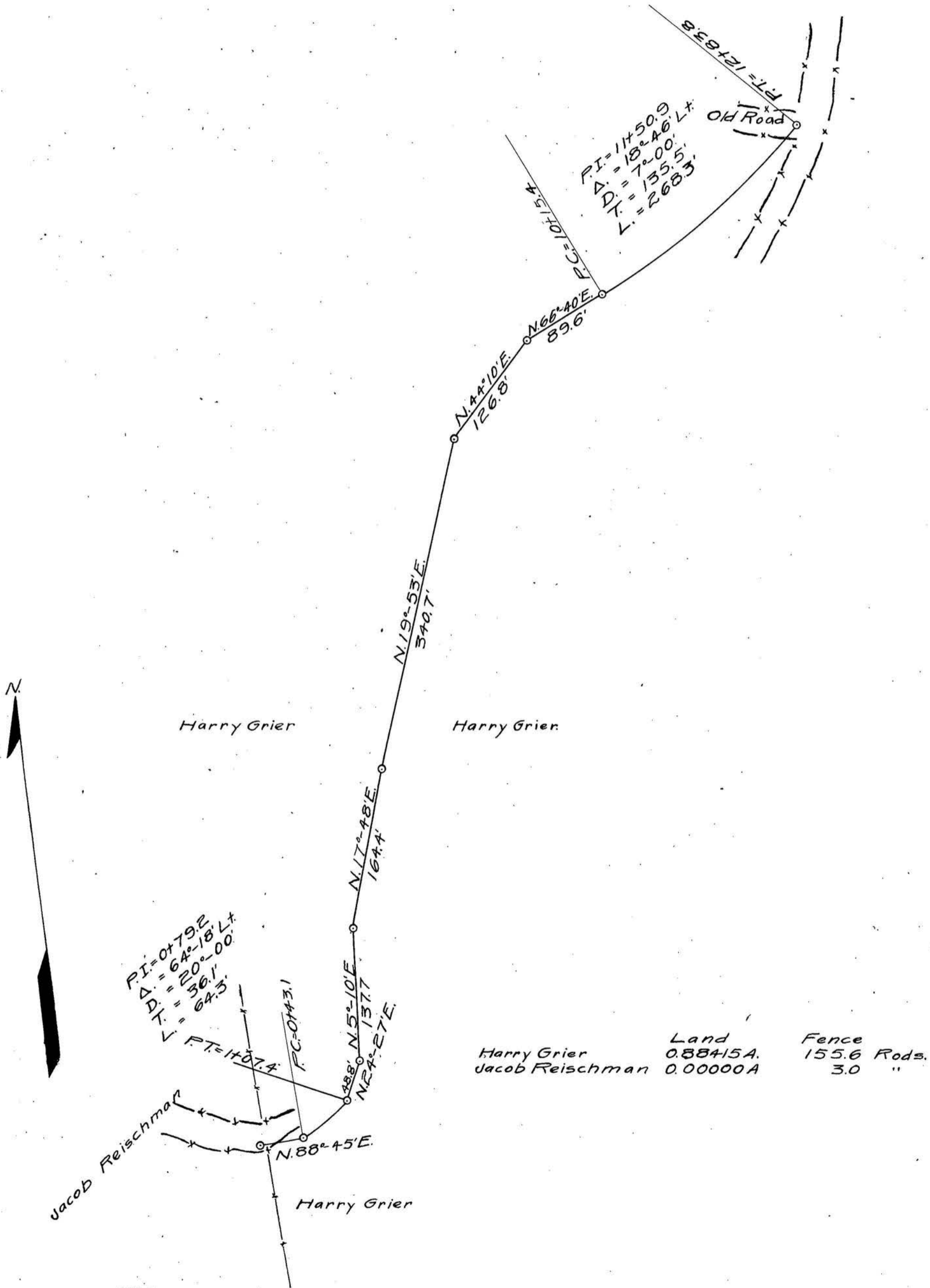
