Shry Commissioners and _____, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the relocation of the public road, petitioned for by Anton Hochevar and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Anton Hochevar and others, in the Martins Ferry Daily Times, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 5th day of August, 1924, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 25th day of August, 1924, the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT ON ROAD

Surveyor's Office, Belmont County,

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

St. Clairsville, Ohio, August 15, 1924

Pursuant to your order dated July 7, 1924, I make my report to you as follows, in the matter of the relocation of the public road petitioned for by Anton Hochevar and others.

1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement but with the following changes, (Route A.) which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: will give the property owners a way out on the south side of the rail road.
2. The width should be 40 feet. The route followed will have a fairly heavy grade but is the best route as the route below would be on ground full of slips which would be difficult to keep up if at all.
3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a * before one name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

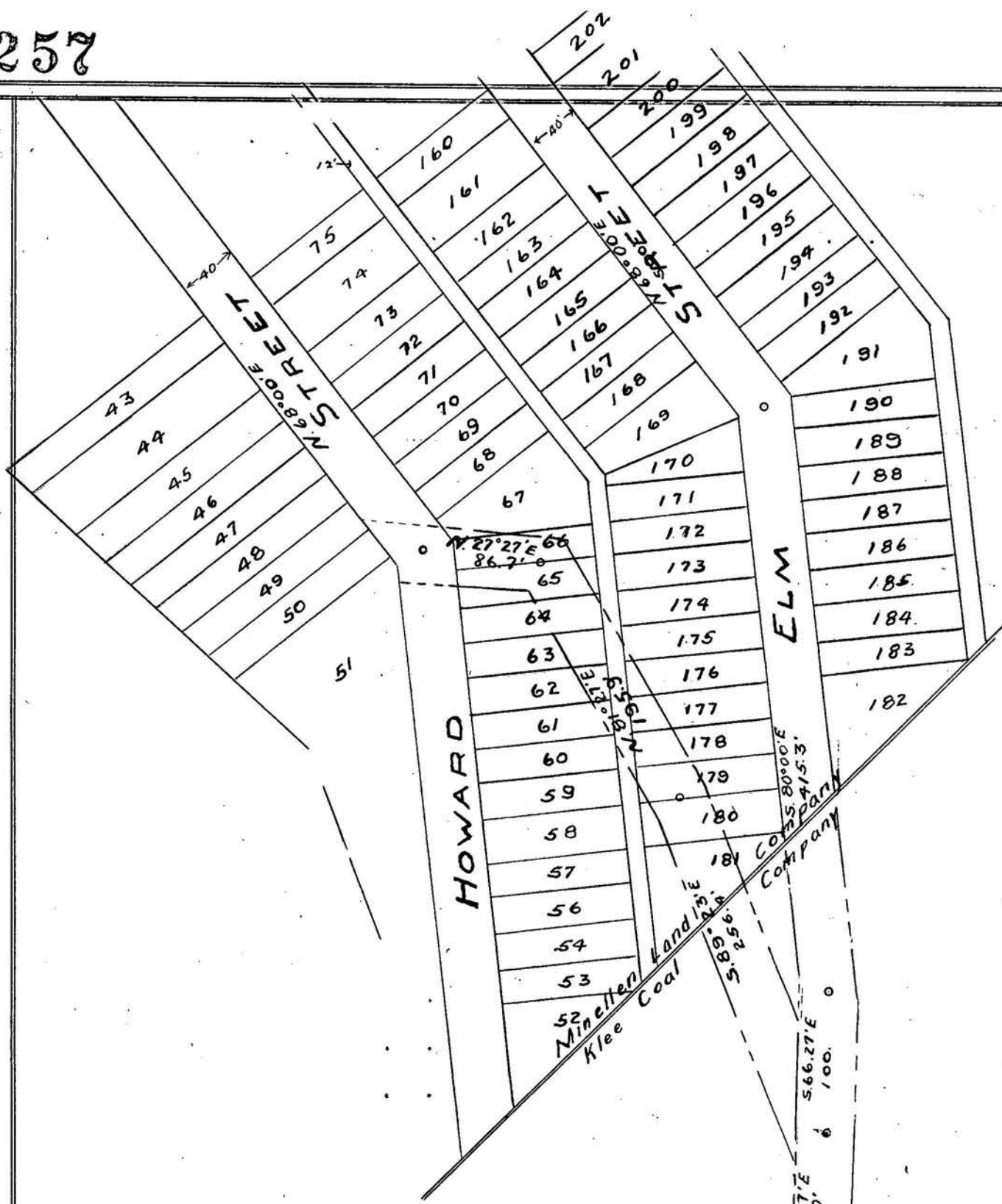
Another route on the east has been mentioned which would run the survey into Elm Street and not Howard Street. This route has some advantage but doubtful whether it is worth the change in survey. Route B. has 2 rather deep hollows which are in Minellen Add. but not in the survey which would require grading and 2-24" by 40' culverts making from 700 to 900 ft. of grading and 2 sewers laying in the Minellen Add. that would have to be done before the road would be in a condition to travel.

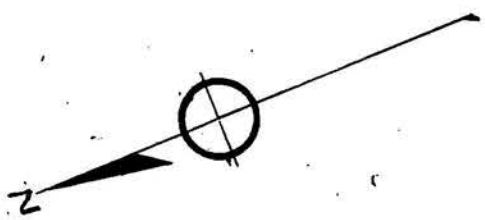

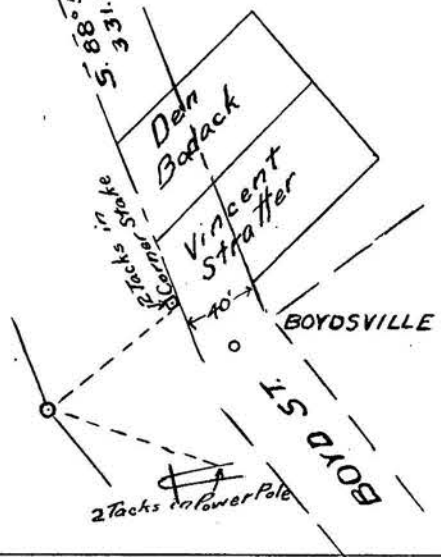
