SURVEYOR'S REPORT ON ROAD

Surveyor's Office, Belmont County,

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

St. Clairsville, Ohio, September 30, 1924

Pursuant to your order dated _____ 1924, I make my report to you as follows, in the matter of the relocation of the public road petitioned for by George W. Donley and others.

1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: is fairly good except on the lower end it is not passable to get the full right of way as the creek is on one side and hill on the other

2. The width should be thirty feet from point 0 to point 8 a 30' right of way will be in buildings, yards, and the run from point 8 to point 10 a 30 foot right of way will be over new

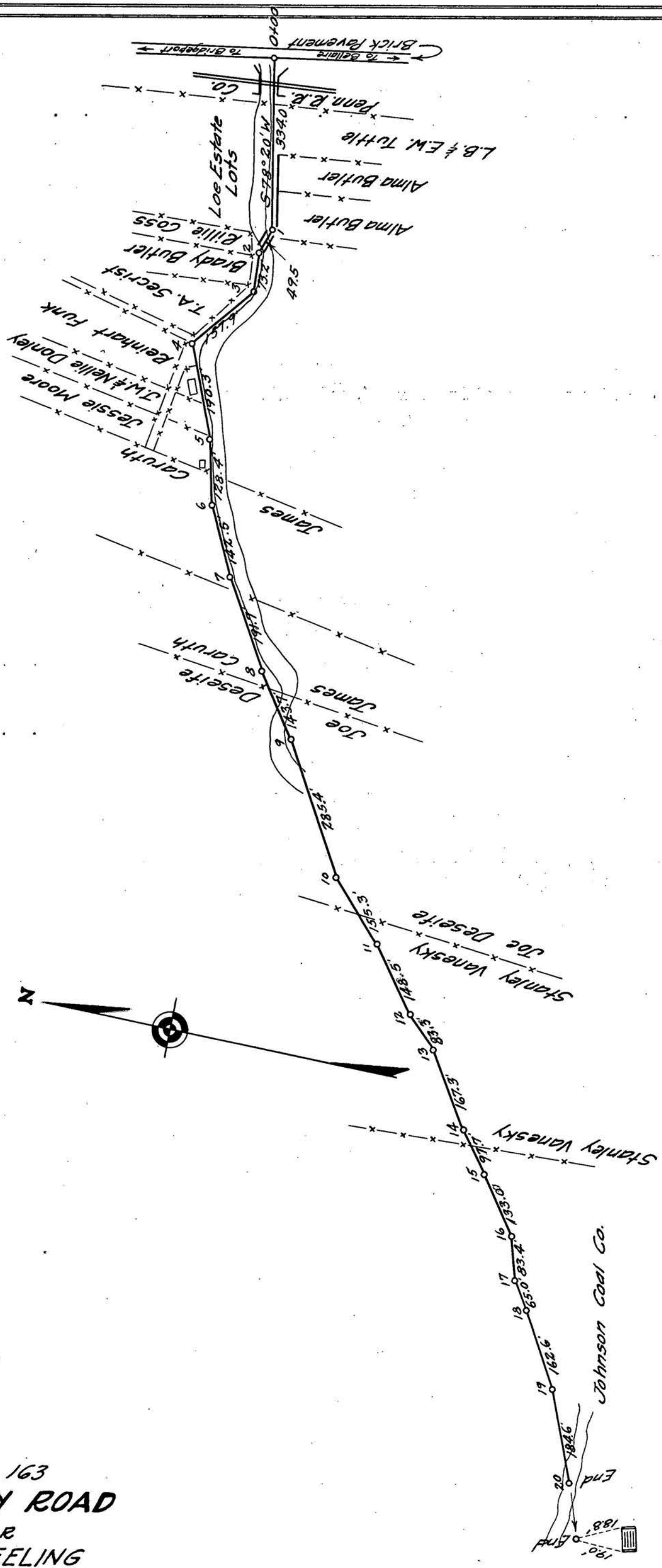
The County Surveyor recommends either A or B route or total rejection of the G. W. Donley road.
