### ROAD PETITION

For the alteration of a Road in Smith Township,  
 Improvement No. 168 Petitioned for by Walker Fulton and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the alteration of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: *Beginning*

Said alteration on this Warnock-Glencoe Road in the S. W. quarter of Section 6, Township 6 and Range 4 in Smith Township, Belmont County, Ohio at a point on the Warnock-Glencoe Road, and near the Frater Coal Bank on said Frater land; thence in a northerly direction on the land of said Steve Freter for a distance of about 50 rods; thence continuing in a same direction and on the lands of Elizabeth F. Fulton, for a distance of about 30 rods to a point on the St. Clairsville road near a small oak tree on the lands of said Elizabeth E. Fulton being a distance of about 75 rods and all in said section 6, township 6 and range 4 of Smith Township.

Said alteration is for the purpose of making a better and more practical grade from the Warnock-Glencoe road to the top of the hill on the St. Clairsville Road.

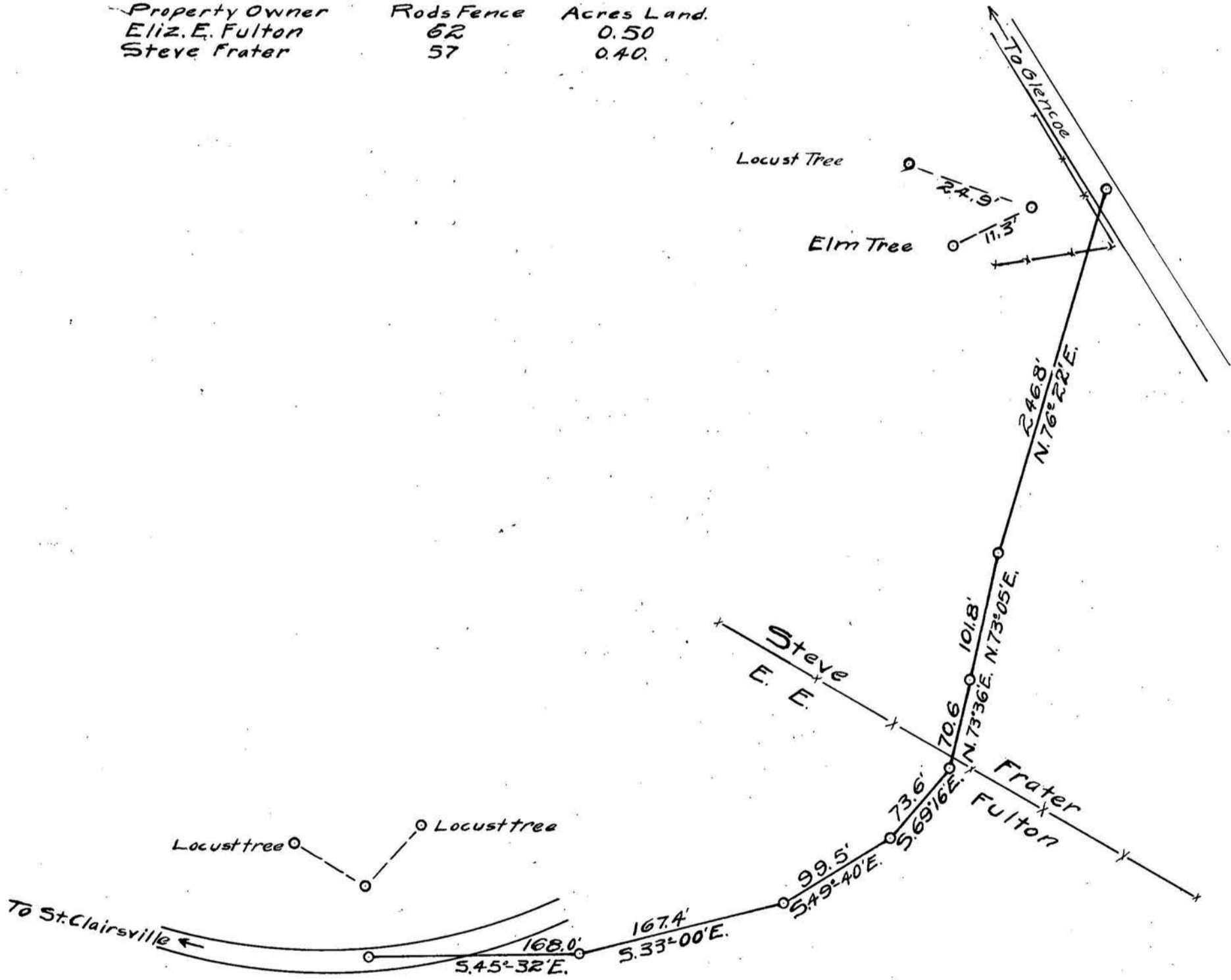
