For the relocation of a Road in Pease Township,

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the relocation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning For said road at Blaine, Pease Township, east of the railroad crossing and at the brick road. Thence along the street R. R. to the Colerain Township line--thence with said road up the hill past the school houses to the intersection of the road leading to Colerain, Ohio. Thence north on or near the said road to the line of William McGraw and Edward Thonen about one mile and one-quarter long.

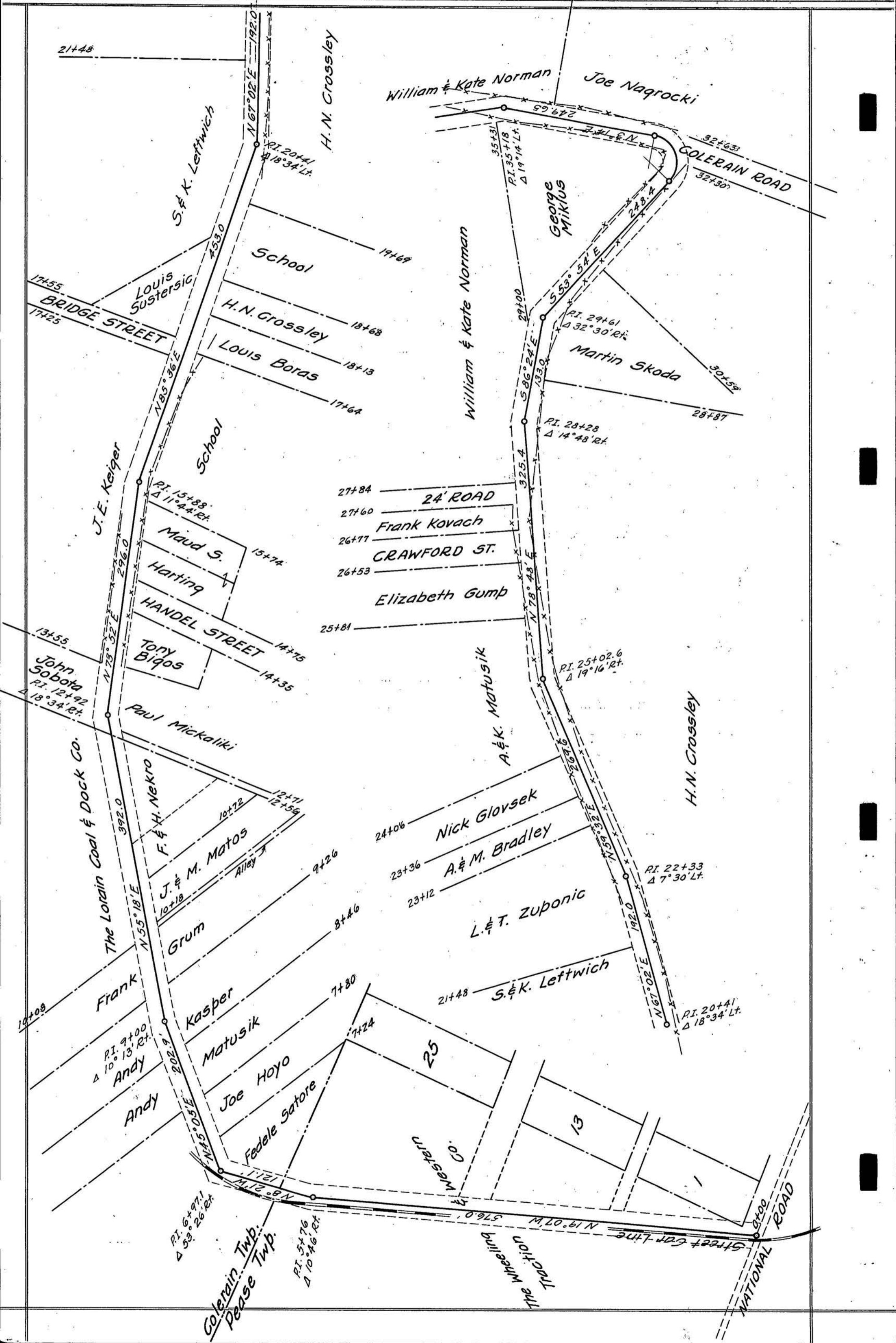
Pursuant to your order dated November 10, 1924, I make my report to you as follows, in the matter of the relocation of the public road petitioned for by Edward Kiger and others.

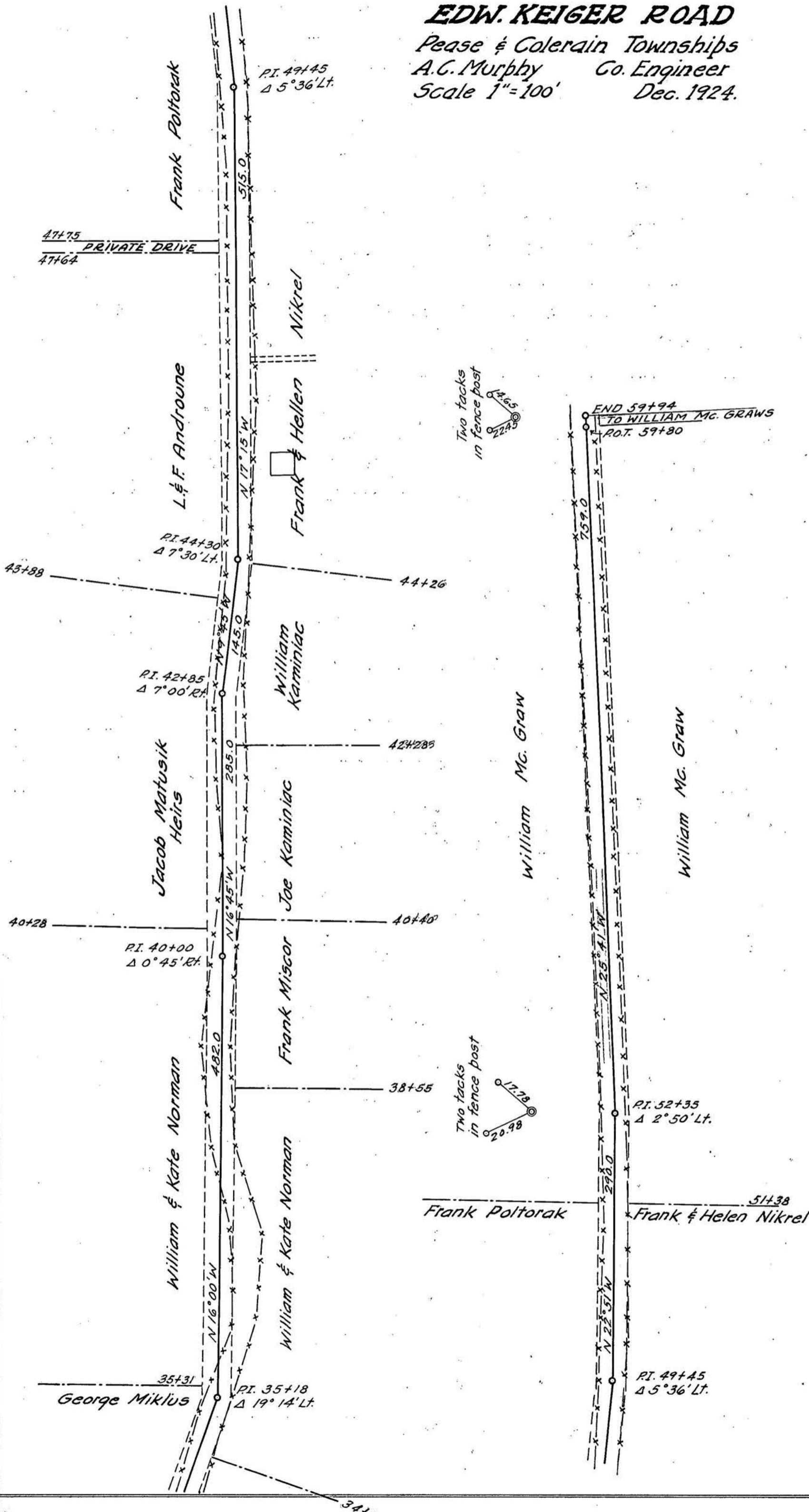
