

ROAD PETITION

For the Alteration & repair of a Road in Warren Township,
 Improvement No. 176 Petitioned for by John O'Brien and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the alteration and repair of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning

At the intersection of the Boston road with the Mt. Hope road in Warren Township and extending in a westerly direction through the farms of Frank Gier, Alexander Harper, Charles Graham, John Woodland, Fred and Gus Forbes, June Edwards, George Douglas, Frank Phillips, Harry McCleary, David Phillips, John Toohey, Jr., Geo. S. Fowler, John O'Brien, The Colburg Coal Company, E. E. Hall and Mrs. John Toohey, Sr. respectively; ending at the intersection of the Mt. Hope road and the Barnesville and Baileys Mills Road; a distance in all of approximately three miles.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Whetstone a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

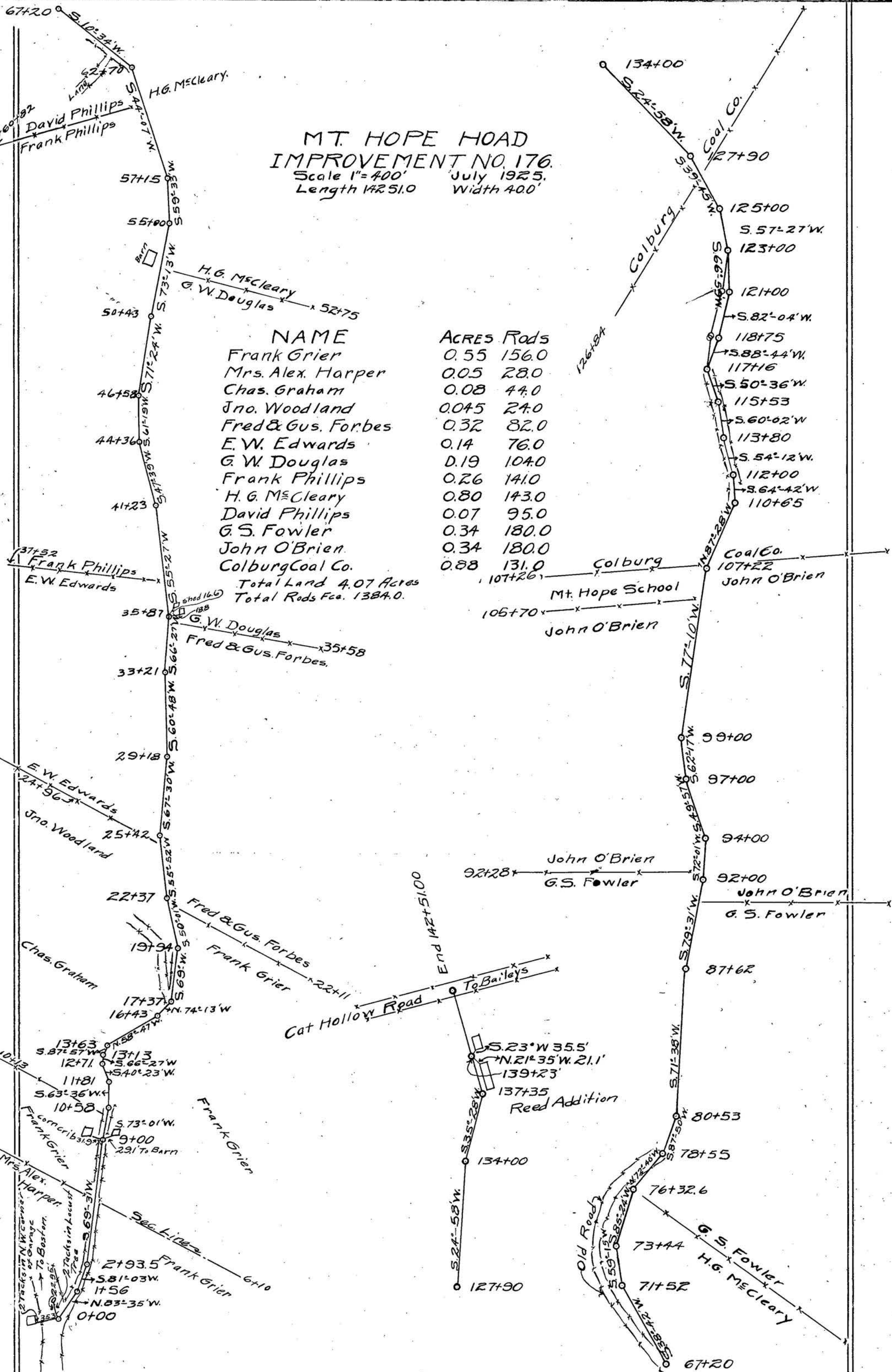
