ROAD PETITION

For the vacation of a Road in Union Township, Improvement No. 178 Petitioned for by Sanford Humphrey and Others

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the vacation of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning At the forks of the road known as the six mile run road and at or near the north-west corner of the south-west quarter of Section 30, Township 8 of Range 5, and on land formerly owned by Mahlon White, Sr. and from thence in a southeasterly direction through said land formerly owned by said Mahlon White, Sr. and now owned by E. Grimsley, et al., and for a distance of about one-half mile to the south line of said section 30; thence almost directly south between the lands of Sanford Humphrey and the land of Wilbur Rankin in the N. W. quarter of Section 29, Township 8, Range 5., and on the land formerly, for the distance of about one-fourth of a mile to what was formerly known as the Chamberlain Mill road or as later known as the Murphy road, making in all a distance of about three-fourths of a mile in length of the road hereby proposed to be vacated.
