

### ROAD PETITION

For the construction of a Road in Richland, Colerian & Pease Township,  
Improvement No. 199 Petitioned for by S. F. Patton and Others

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the construction of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning At the Bridge at the southwest corner of the property formerly occupied by E. N. Boggs as a residence, in Colerain township, said county and extending southeastwardly along the old road, or as near thereto as can be conveniently and economically constructed and extending on southeastwardly by East Loretta and the lands of W. R. Hardesty and S. C. Hardesty and extending on Southeastwardly thru Richland township and thru the lands of Samuel Patton, John Wenzel, Arrick heirs, The Lorain Coal and Dock Co. and on into Colerain township again, thru what was formerly known as the "John DuBois Farm" passing Linwood Cemetery and connecting with the National Road at Blaine, in Pease township, Belmont County; being a distance of approximately four (4) miles.
