Carle and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road petitioned for by W. R. SURVEYOR'S REPORT ON ROAD.

Surveyor's Office, Belmont County,
St. Clairsville, Ohio, February 14 19 16

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

Pursuant to your order dated December 13, 19 15, I make my report to you as follows in the matter of the Alteration of the public road petitioned for by W. R. Carle and others.

1. My opinion is that the granting of the improvement; but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit: and for the following reasons:

1st. A better location; on better road bed; shortens the distance; for better allignment and more suitable curves; good grade and puts the road more nearly above high water line; and more economic of maintenance

2. The width should be Forty feet

3. Estimated Compensation and Damages, due each person, firm or corporation, (with a * before the name of each minor or other person under disability) to-wit:


