That the present road has heavy grades, in places as much as 19% i.e. 19 feet per 100 ft. Stony with many protruding, making traveled road rough, in places the banks are higher than center of road, thus throwing the flow of water toward the center of the road bed. A grade *Hundred* of 7% for 1100feet, then 8% for thrity three feet and remainer 3% running from the north end of bridge over 0. R. & W. R. R. North westerly direction down the hill to the pt. as mentioned as the place of Beg. See plat, profile and cross-section

2. The width should be Forty (40) feet Total distance 5700 feet or 1.08 miles




