

ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in York Township,
Improvement No. 27 Petitioned for by Louis Kriechbaum and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the
Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning for the same at or near the forks of the Arman Hill Road on the Powhatan & Steinersville Pike on I. W. Ramseys farm, at or near 150 feet east of old road in section 8 of said Township; thence through the lands of C. A. Korner in section 14, then back to I. W. Ramsey in Section 8; thence through the lands of G. A. Korner in Section 13; then through the lands of H. E. Arman at or near old road in Section 13; then through the lands of Samuel Arman in Section 13; thence through the lands of H. E. Arman in Section 19, then through the lands of Frank Imhoff in section 19 then through the lands of Lewis Kreichbaur in section 19, then back to the lands of Frank Imhoff through to the Monroe County Line at or near the old road, or any other place the viewers may designate to get a grade not to exceed six degrees. Said Road is located in York Township, Belmont County, Ohio.

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings for said improvement.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present W. N. Miller, F. A. Hagedorn, and W. R. King Commissioners, and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Louis Kreichbaum and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 18th day of June 1917 for the Establishment of a public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said Louis Kreichbaum has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 10th day of July 1917 at 11.00 o'clock A.M. be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point of said proposed road and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 23rd day of July 1917 at one o'clock P.M. as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Bellaire Daily Leader, a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. Arthur Dickson, F. A. Hagedorn, and W. R. King Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Establishment of the public road, petitioned for by Louis Kreichbaum and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road petitioned for by Louis Kreichbaum and others, in the Bellaire Daily Leader, a newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 10th day of July 1917 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 23rd day of July 1917 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose land is to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio:

Pursuant to your order dated July 10, 1917 19, I make my report to you as follows in the matter of the Establishment of the public road petitioned for by Louis Kreichbaum and others.

1. My opinion is in favor of the granting of the improvement; but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit:

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. Arthur Dickson, F. A. Hagedorn, and W. R. King Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that

in the matter of the Establishment of the Public Road petitioned for by Louis Kreichbaum and others, the same came on to be heard for final hearing

on the matter of granting said improvement, on this 23rd day of July 1917, and find that notice thereof has been given as provided by law, and the former orders made herein, and after having made a view of said proposed road improvement, and having had the report of the surveyor read, and heard the protests for and against the same, find that said improvement will serve the public convenience and welfare and

said improvement is granted, and the same is hereby ordered as designated on the plat filed herein by the County Surveyor, and it is further ordered that said road improvement as granted above be established. And this matter now coming on to be heard on the matter of award of Compensation and Damages to abutting land owners, and no claims having been filed asking for Compensation and Damages, and a waiver thereof having been filed as follows, to-wit: "We, the undersigned, being the owners through and upon whose lands it is proposed to locate and establish the County Road known as the Armann Hill Road, in consideration that said proposed road is granted as surveyed by Harry E. Rice County Surveyor, hereby waive all our claim or claims of any kind for Compensation and Damages on account of the establishment of said road through our lands; and we do hereby waive all legal notice required by statute, and do hereby consent to the establishment of said road as aforesaid; Lewis Kreichbaum, F. C. Imhoff, H.E. Armann, Samuel Armann, George A. Korner, I. W. Ramsey." And the Commissioners considering said waiver aforesaid and all claims of minors and those under disabilities, find that there is no compensation or Damages to be awarded. It is further ordered that for hearing claims for compensation and damages

a record of the proceedings and the plat and survey be entered upon the Road Records of the County, and that the Road as described in the petition be opened up and established and shall thereafter be a public road to be kept and maintained and improved as provided by law.
