

## R-O-A-D D-E-D-I-C-A-T-I-O-N

For The Alteration of a Public Road in York Township  
Improvement No. 36. Dedicated by Sailer-Dorsey and Others.

St. Clairsville, Ohio, October 29, 1917.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King, Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Christian Sailer and others having filed a plat in the office of the Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, on this the 29th day of October, 1917, dedicating certain lands for the alteration of Little Captina Road, in York Township, Section 9, Township, 4, Range 3, and known as "Sailer-Dorsey Dedication", with a description of same attached thereto as follows: to-wit: Beginning for the same near an 18 inch elm tree, on the west side of the Little Captina Road, near the foot of the hill on the lands of Margaret Dorsey; thence in a northwesterly direction, and west of the present Road, about 1000 feet, thence in a north-easterly direction about 300 feet to a point in the present Road, about 53 feet south of a 15 inch poplar tree. Being through the lands of Margaret Dorsey, and Christian Sailer. And the same is this day considered by the Board of Commissioners, and it appearing that said plat and description is regular and in conformity to law. It is ordered that the 27th day of November, 1917, at one o'clock P. M. be fixed as a date to view the same at which date they will meet at the commencing point of said proposed road, and go over the route of the same; They also fix the date of December 10, 1917 at one o'clock P. M. as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners, at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted and if granted, a time fixed for hearing for Compensation and Damages. It is further ordered that notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Democrat a newspaper published and having general circulation in the County of Belmont.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the public road, petitioned for by

Christian Sailer and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road petitioned for by

Christian Sailer and others, in the Bellaire Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 27th day of November 1917 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and

did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 10th day of December 1917 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose land is to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

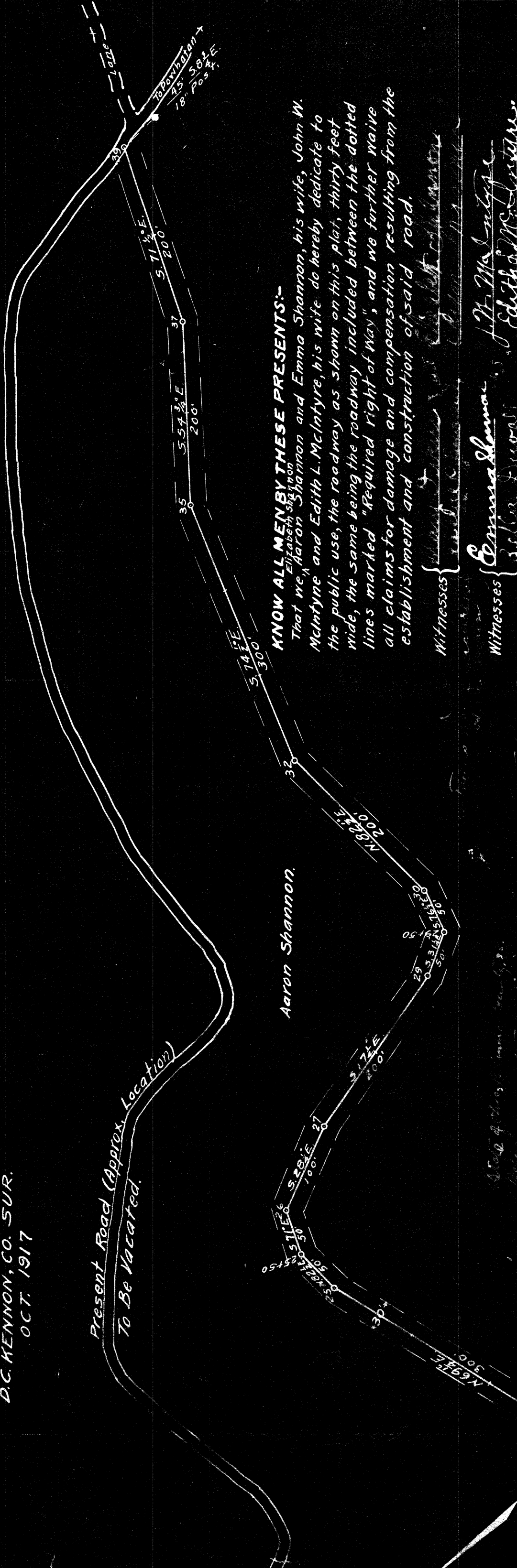
