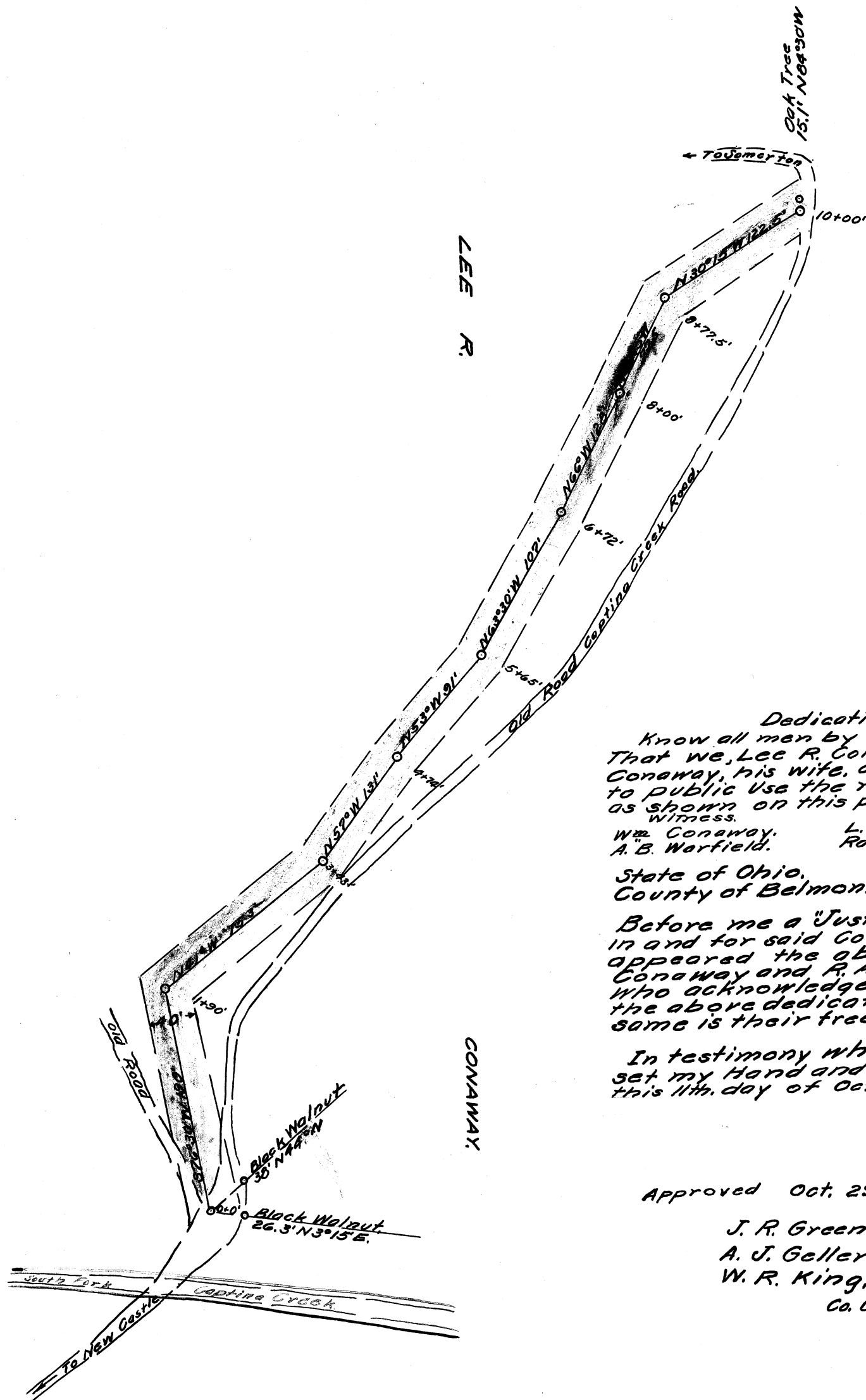


R-O-A-D- D-E-D-I-C-A-T-I-O-N

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller and W. R. King, Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that Lee R. Conoway, having filed a plat in the office of the Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, on this the 29th day of October, 1917, dedicating certain lands for the alteration of Captina Creek Road, in Wayne Township, Section 2, T. 6 R. 5 and known as the "Dedication of Lee R. Conoway Road" with a description attached thereto as follows to-wit:- Beginning for the same about 40 feet northwest of the south fork of Captine Creek S. three degrees 15' W. from Black Walnut, 26.3' northwest of Conoway's House, at the forks of the Roads; thence in a generally northwesterly direction over the lands of Lee R. Conoway for a distance of 10,000 feet to a stake in the Captina Creek Road, which is south 84 degrees, 30' E. from a 15" oak tree. and the same is this day considered by the Board of Commissioners, and it appearing that said plat and description is regular, and in conformity to law. It is ordered that the 4th day of December, 1917, at one o'clock P. M. be fixed as the date to view the same at which date they will meet at the commencing point of said proposed road, and go over the route of the same. They also fix the date of December 31, 1917, at one o'clock P. M. as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and Damages. It is further ordered that notice of the time and place for both such view and hearing be given by publication, once a week, for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Enterprise a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Regular session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the Captina Creek Road in Wayne Township of the public road, ~~petitioned for by~~ the Dedication of Lee R. Conoway and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road ~~petitioned for by~~ so dedicated by Lee R. Conoway and others, in the Barnesville Enterprise newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 4th day of December 1917 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 31st day of December 1917 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, ~~accompanied with statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose land is to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established~~ Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

SURVEYOR'S REPORT ON ROAD.

To the Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio: Pursuant to your order dated December 4, 1917, I make my report to you as follows in the matter of the Dedication of the public road ~~petitioned for by~~ Lee R. Conoway and others.

- 1. My opinion is in favor of the granting of the improvement; ~~with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to wit~~ and shown by the map and description filed with the dedication for such improvement.
- 2. That further surveys, plats etc. are unnecessary.

And it is further ordered that the Auditor cause notice in writing to be given to the owner or owners through or upon whose lands said improvement is established, and this matter is adjourned to said date.
