

ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Somerset Township, Improvement No. 41 Petitioned for by E. L. Willison and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning on the ridge road leading from Somerton, Ohio, to Temperanceville, Ohio, at a lane just east of B. T. Neptune's house; thence South along said lane to the line of an old road running east and west; thence east with the line of said old road about one hundred yards; thence south to the Boston and Somerton road, intersecting the same at a point just east of a small bridge and west of an old log stable on the J. E. Broomhall Farm. Said Road being located in Somerset Township, Belmont County, Ohio.

E. L. Willison and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Bel-
mont County, for the Establishment of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the
compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the
Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS
AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings for said improvement.

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King Commissioners, and Bert W. Hopkins Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that E. L. Willison and others, have filed a petition in the office of the Commissioners of the County, on the 15th day of April 1918 for the Establishment of a

public road, along the following route, to-wit: Beginning on the ridge road leading from Somerton Ohio to Temperanceville, Ohio, at a lane just east of D. T. Neptune's House; thence south along said land to the line of an old road running east and west; thence East with the line of said old road about 100 yards; thence south to the Boston and Somerton Road, intersecting the same at a point just east of a small bridge and west of an old log stable on the J. E. Broomhall farm said road being located in Somerset Township, Belmont County, Ohio.

the same was this day considered by the Commissioners, and it appearing that said petition is regular and in conformity to law, and that the said E. L. Willison has filed herein a bond as required by law. It is ordered that the 28th day of May 1918 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. be fixed as a date to view the same, at which date they will meet at the commencing point and go over the route of said proposed road.

They also fixed the 17th day of June 1918 at 10:00 o'clock A.M. as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted, and if granted, a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Barnesville Whetstone a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.

Willison and others, in the Barnesville Whetstone, a newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 28th day of May 1918 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 17th day of June 1918 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, ~~accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose lands to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established~~ Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

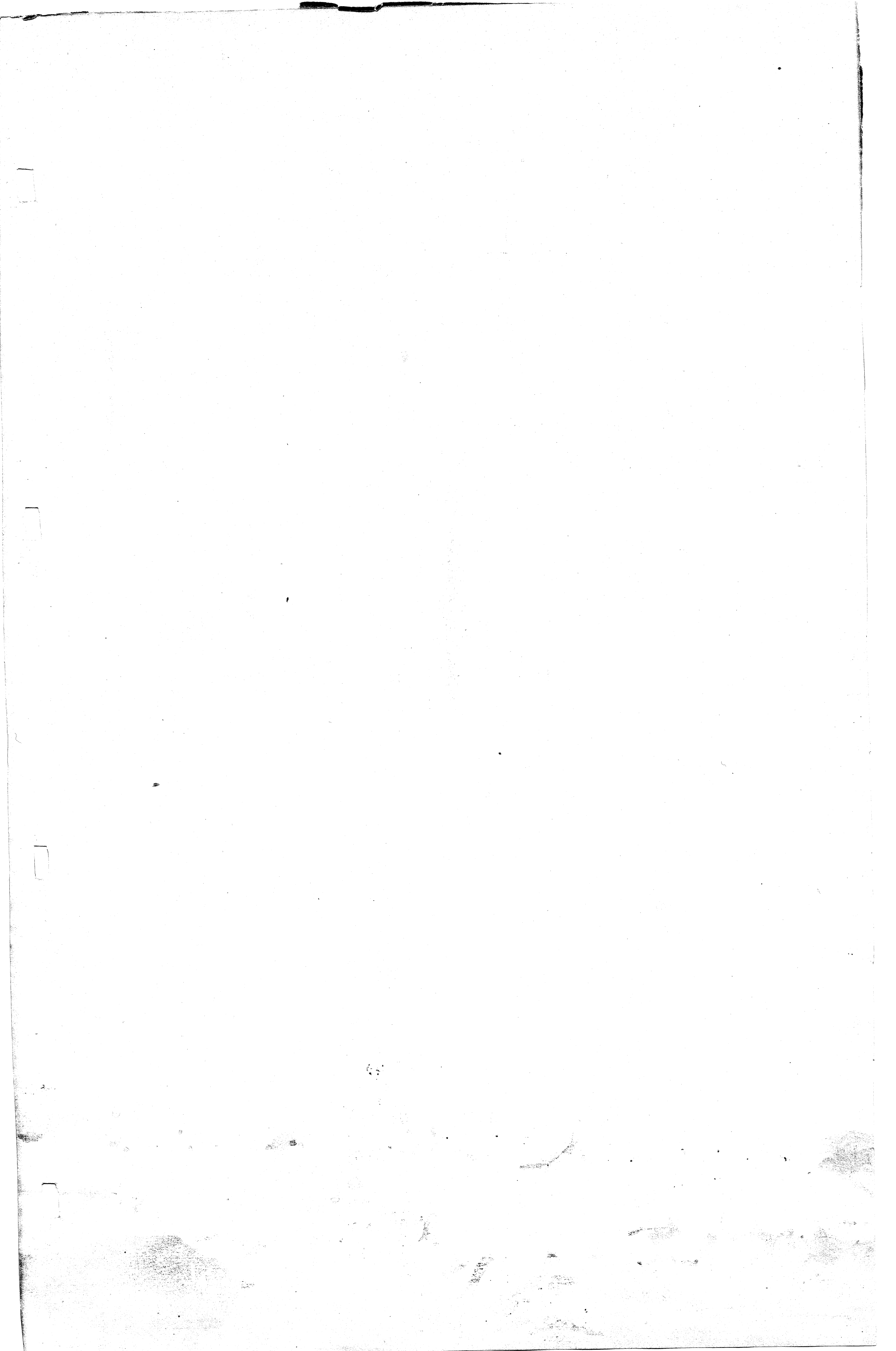

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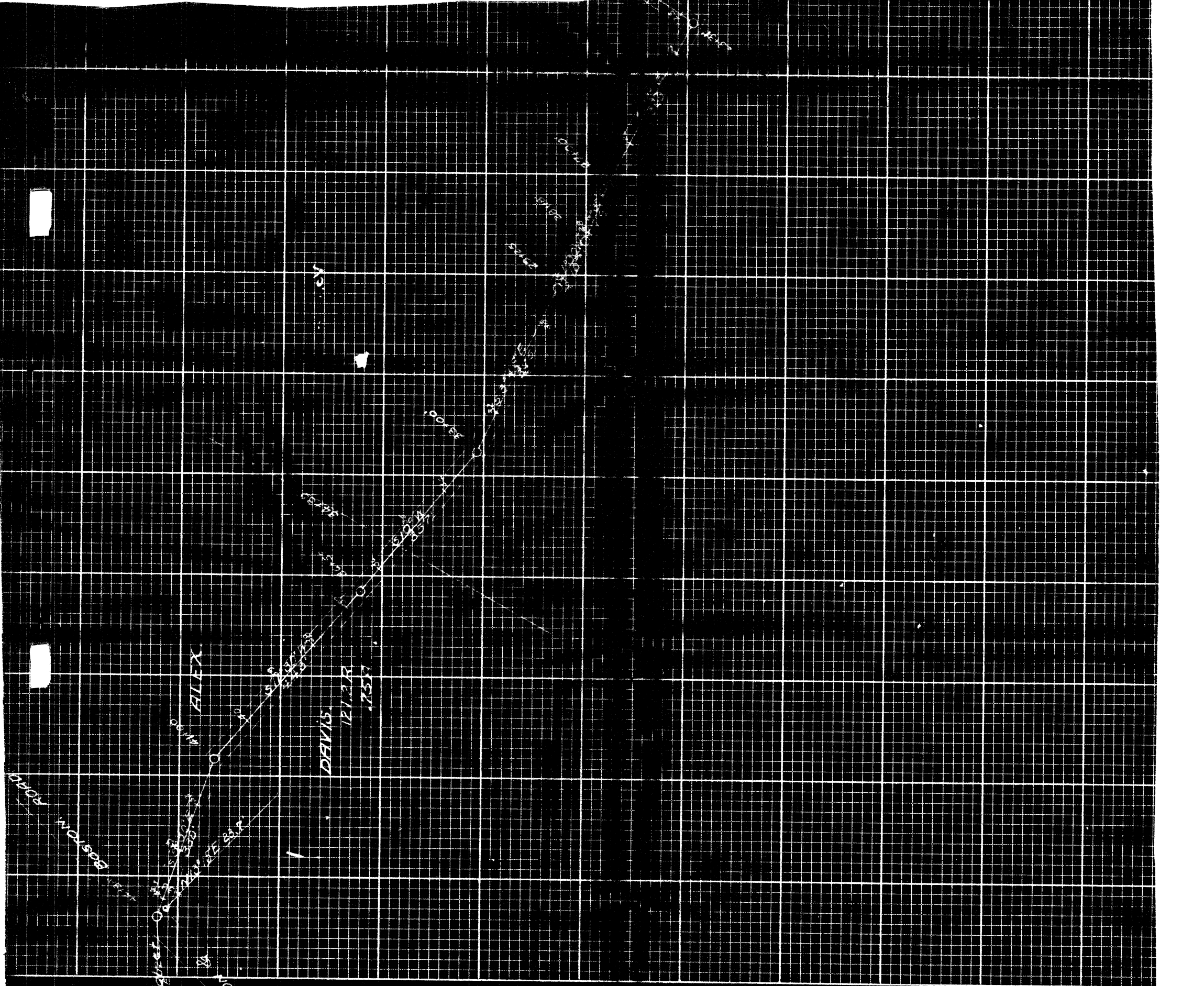
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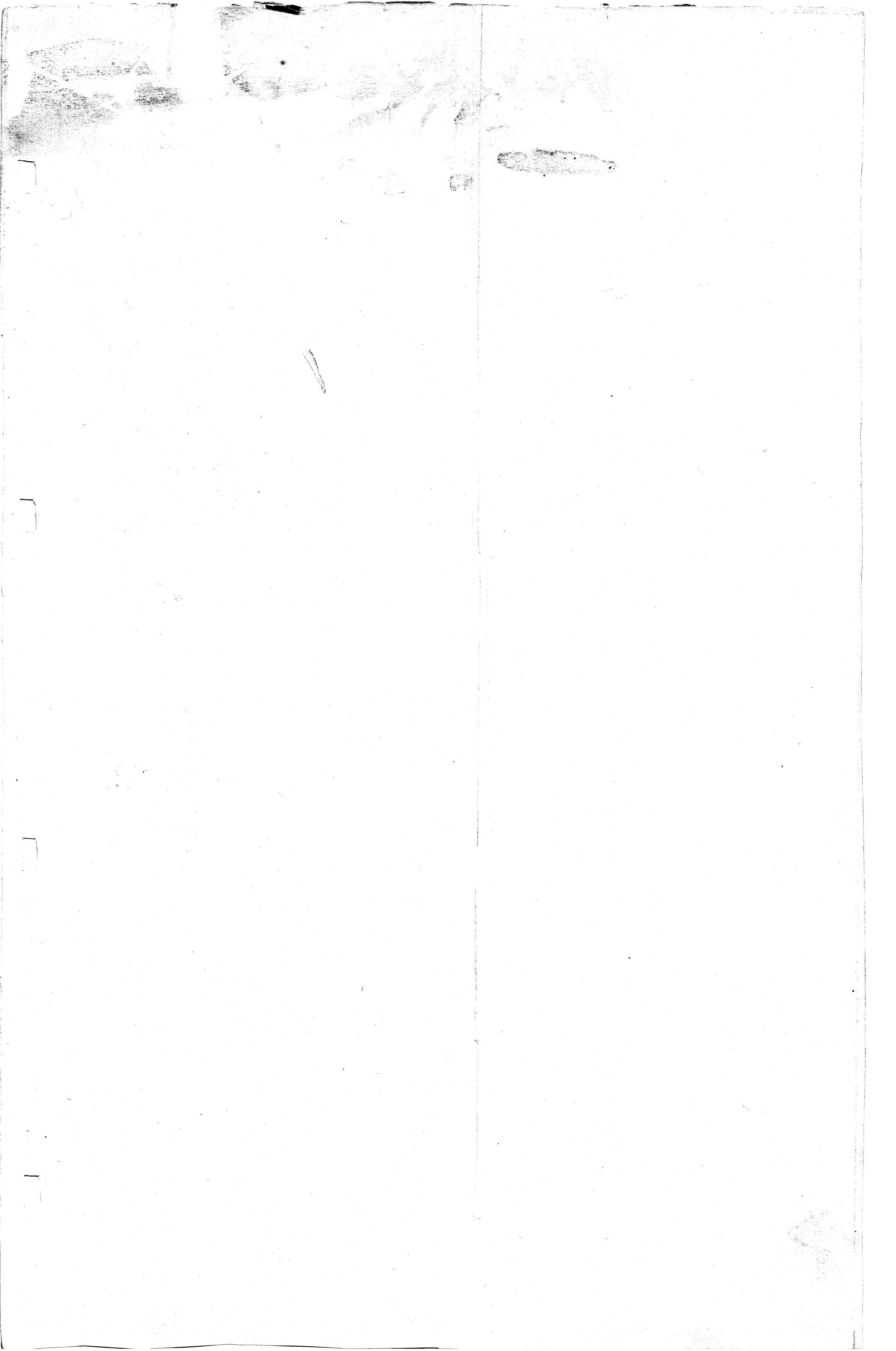

Hopkins Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Establishment of the public road, Improvement No. 44 petitioned for by E. L. Willison and others, this day this cause came on for hearing in the matter of award of compensation and damages to adjoining landowners and the commissioners find that notice of the time and place of this hearing has been given to all the owners of land taken for such improvement or abutting thereon, as provided by law, and the former orders herein. That after hearing all applications for compensation and damages filed herein, and considering all claims of minors and those under disabilities, in the judgment of the commissioners there is awarded and due to the following persons the sums respectively opposite their names.
