St. Clairsville, Ohio, May 6, 1918

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special Session, Present, J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King, Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and secretary of the Board. The minutes of the preceding meeting read, approved and signed, and it appearing that J. E. Lantz and others having filed a plat in the office of the commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, on the 6th day of May, A. D. 1918, dedicating certain lands for the Alteration and Change of the Loydsville-Belmont Road, in Union Township, Section 2 & 3, T. 8, R. 5, and known as the "Lantz-Drennen" Dedication, with a description of same attached thereto as follows, to-wit: Beginning for the same at a telephone pole opposite the Plainfield Church Lot and running in a southwesterly direction through the lands of H. R. and W. D. Drennen, and Estella and J. E. Lantz, a distance of 900 feet to a point in the road leading to Belmont, in the County of Belmont and State of Ohio, which plat, etc., was on the 6th day of May, 1918 accepted and approved by the Commissioners of said County as provided by section 6886, General Code of Ohio. It is ordered that the 18th day of June, 1918, at 11:00 o'clock A. M. be fixed as the date to view the same at which date they will meet at the commencing point of said proposed road, and go over the route of the same. They also fixed the date of July 1st, 1918 at 1:00 o'clock P. M. as the date for final hearing at the office of the County Commissioners at which time it will be considered whether said improvement will be granted and if granted a time fixed for hearing claims for compensation and damages. It is further ordered that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by Publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Gazette a paper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont

The Board of Commissioners of Belmont County, Ohio, met this day in Special session, present J. R. Greenlee, A. J. Geller, and W. R. King Commissioners and Bert W. Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the public road, petitioned for by Dedication of J. E. Lantz and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view the road petitioned for by Dedicated by J. E. Lantz and others, in the Gazette, a newspaper of general circulation in said county as required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the commissioners on this 18th day of June 1918 met at the time and place in said notice designated, and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor, make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 1 day of July 1918 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, ~~accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation, whose lands are to be taken, if the proposed improvement is established.~~ Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than 30 feet nor more than 60 feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.
