

### ROAD PETITION

For the Location and Establishment of a Road in Pultney Township,  
Improvement No. 52 Petitioned for by F. J. Nelson and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

*The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the*

*Change of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning at or near the intersection of Trumbull and 44th Street in the City of Bellaire, Township of Pultney, County of Belmont and State of Ohio, and running thence through the lands of Herman Hardenstein, Rosser and Robinson, James Dunfee; thence following a certain right of way through the lands known as the Dr. Clark Farm, intersecting the already surveyed road at the property of Ladiga, thence following the said surveyed road through the lands of Heirs of Robert Nelson, Lewis A. Steele and Weineke, terminating at the Public Road leading from West Wheeling to the Rock Hill School House.*

The conditions of the above obligation are such, that WHEREAS, application has been made by F. J. Nelson and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Belmont County, for the location & establishment of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings for said improvement.
