

ROAD PETITION

For the Location and Establishment of a Road in Washington Township,
 Improvement No. 53 Petitioned for by T. W. Brown and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Location and Establishment *of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning* at the end of the lane where T. W. Brown enters the Public Road, thence in a easterly direction through the lands of T. W. Brown and wife, thence in a easterly direction through the lands of O. C. Williamson and wife, thence in an easterly direction through the lands of L. D. Moore and Julia A. Moore, crossing Piney Creek at the mouth, thence in an easterly direction through the lands of Crawford Perkins intersecting the road at Crawford Perkins residence. All damages and costs to be paid by the County but said road to be build by Washington Township.

It is further ordered, that notice of the time and place of both such view and hearing be given by publication once a week for three consecutive weeks in the Democrat a newspaper published and having a general circulation in the County of Belmont.
