

ROAD PETITION

For the Construction of a Road in Warren Township,
Improvement No. 72 Petitioned for by John L. Mahoney and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Construction of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning for the same at or near a point where what is commonly known as two "cat hollow" roads fork at the bridge on the lands of John Nichols and William McCoy in Warren Township, Belmont County, Ohio, and running thence in a general Westerly direction through the lands of the said John Nichols, John L. Mahoney and E. S. Doudna, The Media Coal Company and James Gray to the outlet from James Grey's home to Leatherwood Pike

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if, 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the
compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the
Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS
AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

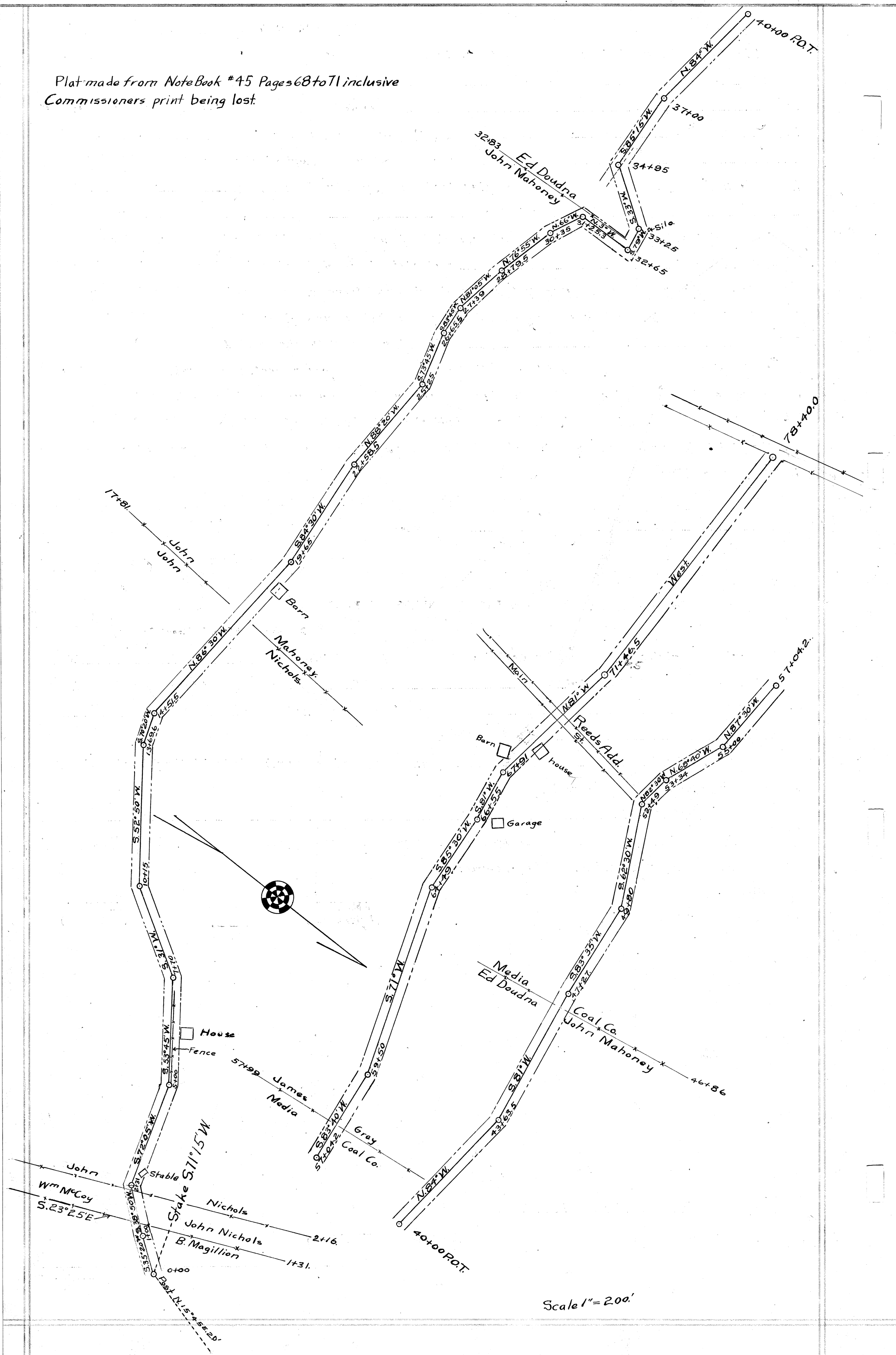
