

ROAD PETITION

For the Establishment of a Road in Pultney Township,
Improvement No. 75 Petitioned for by Charles Rosser and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the

Establishment of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: *Beginning* at or near the intersection of Trumbull and Forty-Fourth Streets in the City of Bellaire, Township of Pultney, County of Belmont, and State of Ohio, and running thence through the lands of Hermann Hardenstein, Rosser and Robinson, James Dunfee; thence following a certain right of way through the lands known as the Dr. Clark farm intersecting the already surveyed road at the property of Ladiga, and thence following said surveyed road through the lands of heirs of Roabert Nelson, Lewis A. Steel and Weineke, terminating at the public road leading from West Wheeling to the Rock Hill school house.

Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.
