

### ROAD PETITION

For the Alteration and establishing of a Road in Mead Township,  
 Improvement No. 77 Petitioned for by L. W. Unterzuber and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

*The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the* Alteration and establishing *of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: Beginning* in the Wegee Creek Road on the south Boundary line of the Village of Shadyside; thence southerly and following said road as near as practicable to the property of the Cambria Collieries Company, formerly owned by Dixon Hepburn, in the South-west quarter of Section 8, Township 5, range 3, in Mead Township, and to a point west of and near the intersection of the Crow Hill Road with said Wegee Creek Road; thence leaving said Wegee Creek Road and keeping on the north side of Wegee Creek, through the lands of The Cambria Collieries Company and through the lands of J. D. Myers in Section 14, township 5, range 3, to a point in the Wegee Creek Road west of the Railroad Bridge and at or near the lands of Selma Bommer; thence south-westerly through the lands of Selma Bommer, the lands of Lillie O. Day, the lands of Clifford Slay formerly owned by Matilda Slay, the lands of U. S. Day, the land of Andrew Spitzl, and the lands of S. L. Kirkland, to a point in the Wegee Ridge Road near the line between the lands of said S. L. Kirkland, to a point in the Wegee Ridge Road as near as practicable to Key, Ohio, making such changes in the aforesaid portions of the two established roads above mentioned as may be necessary and practicable.
