

### ROAD PETITION

For the Alteration and Dedication of a Road in Wayne Township,  
Improvement No. 87 Petitioned for by Jacob and Monta Jenewein and Others.

TO THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BELMONT COUNTY, OHIO:

The undersigned petitioners resident freeholders of said County, residing in the vicinity of the proposed improvement hereinafter described, respectfully represent that the public convenience requires the Alteration and Dedication of a Public Road on the line hereinafter described; and pray that you will institute and order the proper proceedings for said improvement, to-wit: *Beginning* for the same at th center line of the East side of concrete bridge over Mike's Run; thence South 75 degrees East 132 feet to a stake; thence south 30 degrees East 33 feet to a stake; thence south 38 degrees West 130 feet to a stake; thence South 58 degrees West 328 feet to a stake; thence South 46 degrees West 35 feet to a stake; thence due South 42 feet to a stake; thence South 20 degrees East 81 feet to a stake; thence South 40 degrees East 119 feet to a stake; thence South 41 degrees East 185 feet to a stake; thence South 43 degrees East 188 feet to a stake; thence South 52 degrees East 122 feet to a stake; thence South 83 degrees East 101 feet to a stake; thence South 85 degrees 45 feet east 104 feet to a stake, said stake being South 10 degrees East 26 feet from a fence post and also South 18 degrees 30' West 28 feet from a fence post. All of which being on the lands of Jacob and Monta Jenewein. *Sec. 4*

Hopkins, Auditor and Secretary of the Board, and it appearing that in the matter of the Alteration of the public road, petitioned for by Jacob & Monts Jenewein and others, due and proper notice, proof of which is on file in this office, having been given of the time and place of meeting, to view road petitioned for by Jacob & Monts Jenewein and others, in the The Enterprise, a newspaper of general circulation in said county required by law, and the former orders of this Board, the Commissioners on this 7th day of October 1919, met at the time and place in said notice designated and did view the route of said proposed road improvement, and considering such improvement to be of sufficient public importance, it is ordered that the County Surveyor make a plat and survey of the same and report to the Board in writing on or before the 27th day of October 1919 the time set for the hearing, and shall set forth in said report his opinion either for or against the granting of such proposed improvement, accompanied with a statement of the estimated compensation and damages due each person, firm or corporation whose land is to be taken if the proposed improvement is established. Such report shall also state the width of said improvement, which shall not be less than thirty feet nor more than sixty feet, and also recommend any changes in the improvement, which in his judgment, should be made.

3. Estimated compensation and damages, due each person, firm or corporation (with a \* before the name of each minor or other person under disability), to-wit:

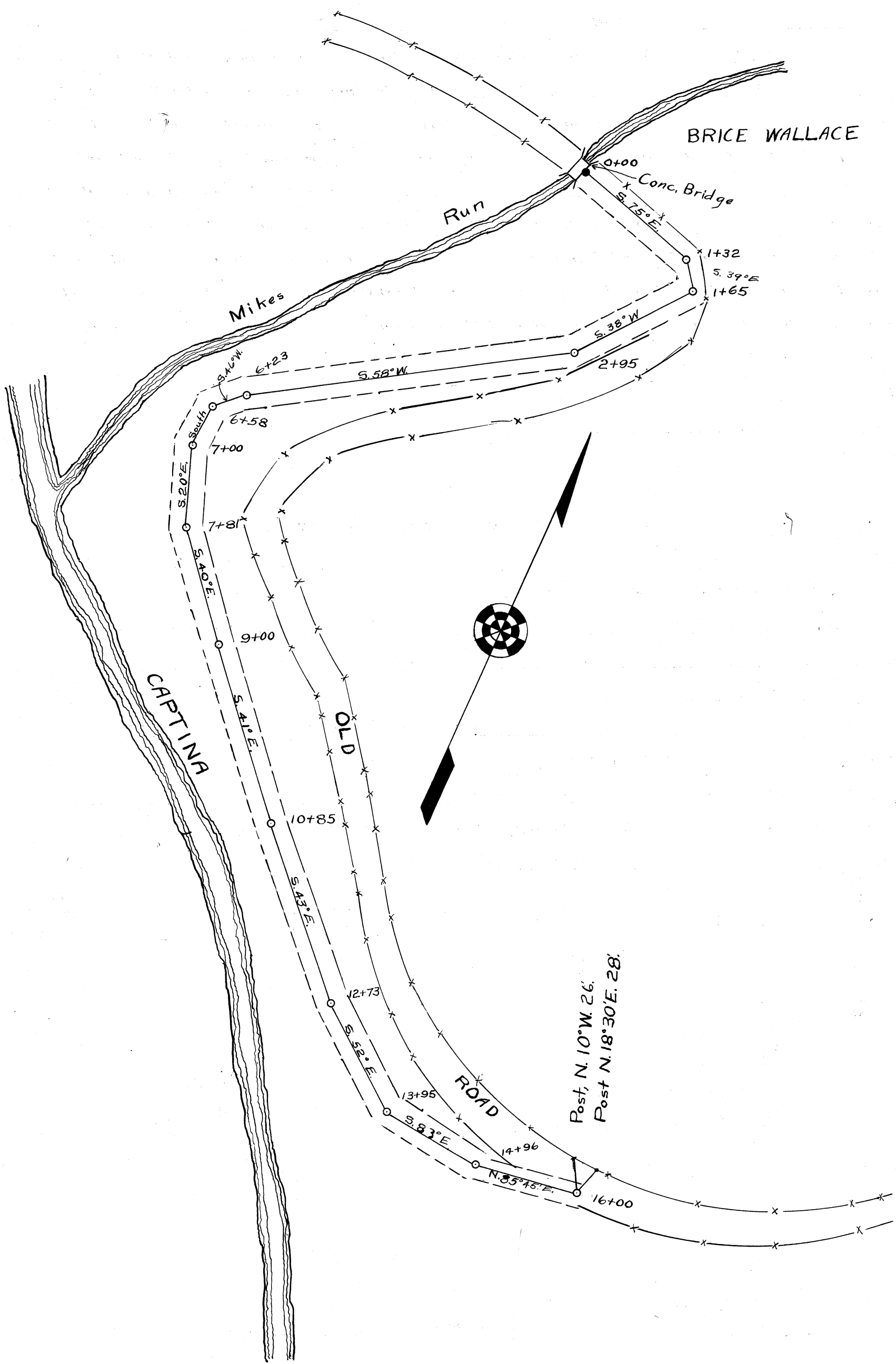
