The conditions of the above obligation are such, that WHEREAS, application has been made by Charles W. Clark and others to the Board of Commissioners of the said Belmont County, for the Alteration of a public road, on briefly the following line, to-wit:

THEREFORE if, 1st. The petition be not granted; or if, 2nd. The Commissioners shall order a portion of the compensation and damages to be paid by the petitioners, and the petitioners fail to pay same by the time fixed by the Commissioners: Then in either such case the said applicants will pay into the treasury of said County the COSTS AND EXPENSES incurred in the proceedings of said improvement.

1. My opinion is the granting of the improvement; but with the following changes, which in my judgment should be made, to-wit:

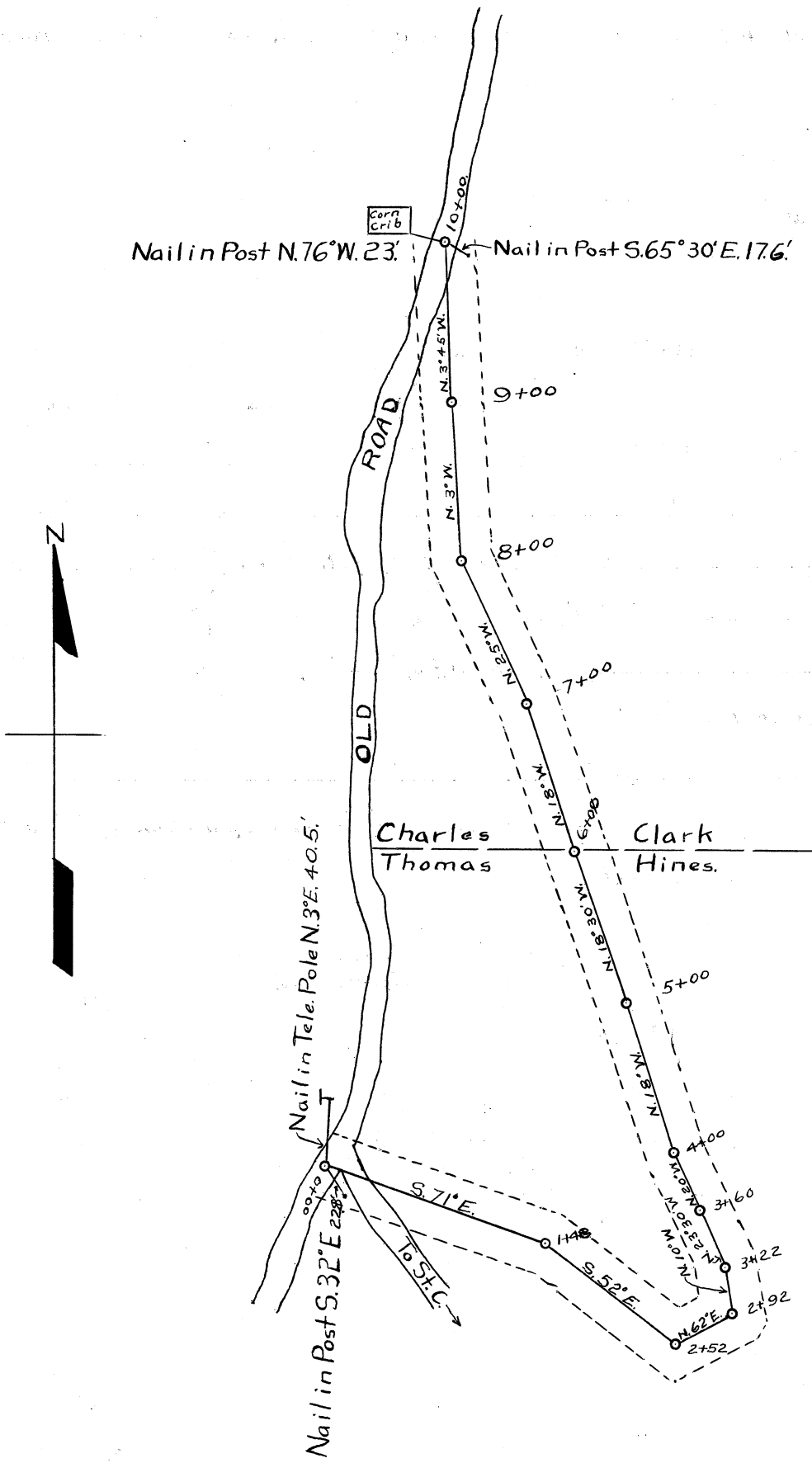
